THIRTIETH ANNUAL FAIR.

THE THIRD DAY.

The third day of the great Fair opened under very auspicious circumstances yesterday. The city from early dawn was thronged, and the successive trains and omnibuses brought in crowds of visitors. It is estimated that upwards of 35,000 strangers were in the city yesterday, and that fully that number visited the Exhibition grounds. The weather, although disagreeable, was not such a nature as to detract from the success of the exhibition. The various avenues leading to the fair grounds were thronged with the fair ground and many of the vehicles were used in conveying them to and from the grounds. All stages, omnibuses and carriages in the city were called in requisition, and some from Hull and other suburban villages, to do duty, and in addition to this, thirteen steamers had already engaged the greater part of the day to discharge their respective passengers, but did not succeed in finishing their work. The price list is so extensive, and space so limited, that it is utterly impossible to give it in full. The live stock, with the exception of four classes, which were unfinished last night, is given in full, and our readers will be pleased to find that Ottawa exhibitors have done nobly in their competition with the great men of the West. The winners of prizes for agricultural implements will be published to-morrow. The implements, without exception, were excellent both as regards manufacture and contrivance. Indeed the whole show yesterday was a grand success—one exhibitor from Montreal declaring it to be the largest he had ever seen, and he had himself been an exhibitor at Toronto, Hamilton, London, Montreal and elsewhere.
