The Sombra Tragedy.

SARITA, Oct. 29.—On the morning of Saturday, the 22nd of May last, there was committed to the honorable Society of Councils of London, about four miles from the village of Wallaseburg, one of the foulest and most cold-blooded murders known in the history of the world.

The victim was a respectable and well-to-do farmer, named Ralph Spence Finlay. He was unusually well educated for his position, and had spent some time in the township of Dover as a married man, and the father of several young children.
