CHARGES AGAINST THE CITY ENGINEER.

We understand that Ald. LeStrat has directed the City Clerk to convene a meeting of the special committee charged with the duty of inquiring into the allegations of malfeasance brought by Mr. J. H. Dwyer, against Mr. Surtees, the City Engineer, and that it is the purpose of the committee to meet this afternoon at four o'clock, and if necessary in the evening also. The accuser and the accused have been notified to hold themselves in readiness, with such witnesses and proofs as they may desire to bring forward, and as the master is one which has already occasioned a great deal of unpleasant talk, it is to be hoped it will be so thoroughly sifted that it may be disposed of and finally set at rest. The public being largely interested in the issue, we shall make it our duty to give the evidence to-morrow morning's Times.

THE WEALTH OF NEW SOUTH WALES.

We have received from the Australian Commissioners to the Centennial Exhibition a very interesting map of the mineral resources of New South Wales, together with tabulated statements of the agricultural products, mineral yields and commercial operations of the colony, which, in view of the projected movement for direct trade between the colony and Canada, is of some importance and interest to us on this side of the globe. The colony of New South Wales is evidently a pastoral country, both as regards climate and pastoral pastures, two of the principal factors in successful agriculture, and for many years now it has been famous all the world over as a great stock raising country. Indeed the natural advantages with which the colony has been favoured have made farming easy and pastoral pursuits pleasant and profitable. The progress and prosperity of the colony have been mainly based upon the agricultural industry, and the great test of its value and importance in the colonial economy is to be found in the wealth accumulated in the form of stock. The principal stock raised, both with regard to value and numbers, is that of sheep, which in 1875 was estimated to number 22,572,882, or the population being 600,000, thirty-eight per head of the population. The wool produced by this immense herd of animals weighed in the aggregate 62,900,425 pounds; and the value of the clip was \$5,341,702. Being of the finest texture, generally speaking, it commands the highest price in the greatest market of the world, Monga street, London, which regulates prices and supplies manufacturers with the bulk of their raw material. The numbers of other classes of live stock in the Colony are: Horned cattle, 2,856,499, or 32 per head of the population; horses, 346,691; and pigs, 219,958. The exports of live stock and their produce, in 1874, the last year of the complete returns, we presume, were of the following values: Wool, £30,012; live stock, £77,235; leather, £154,893; skins, £104,151; preserved meats, £107,412; and hides, £53,771; total value of £6,202,288; or, in currency, \$30,243,919. The arable produce is given as follows, the extent of land under cultivation being 454,957 acres:—Wheat, 2,145,394 bush.; maize, 2,618,436 bush.; barley 69,053 bush.; oats, 29,135 bush.; potatos, 1,254,504 tons; arrowroot, 29,703 lbs.; sagoes (productive), 15,355,645 lbs.; and tobacco, 6,059 ewt. The product of the vineyards is given as follows:—Wine, 684,258 gallons; brandy, 1,859 gallons; and fruit for table use, 679 tons. Another source of wealth and prosperity has been found in the mineral fields and metallic deposits of the colony. The most famous and productive of these, hitherto, has been the gold fields which have attracted population to the country and supplied circulating medium to the world. The area of these fields is given at 13,650

square miles. The value of their total production up to 1874 was £30,636,246; and the exports of the precious metal in that year was £1,875,081. Important and valuable as the resources of these fields have been, it is probable that there are other natural resources in the colony which will be of still greater value in the future and more permanent in their influence upon the prosperity of the country. Prominent among these natural sources of wealth are the coal fields, with an estimated area of 24,840 square miles, an area three times greater than the coal area of Great Britain, and one third greater than that of British North America. The industry connected with these fields is yet in its infancy; but up to the end of 1874, there had been 12,487,279 tons raised, of the estimated value of \$46,688,285; and in that year the output of the mines was 1,104,567 tons. The next in importance to the coal fields are the deposits of iron ore. Mining for these may be said to be an undeveloped industry; but the value of the deposits, both as regards extent and quality, has been fully established, and the attention of capitalists has been directed to their utilization. At some not very remote period, these deposits will, without doubt, become a direct source of wealth to the colony, and in connection with the coal fields and the industries which will conjointly give birth to them, will be found employment for a large and industrious population. The approximate area of the iron deposits is given as 1,600 square miles. Next in importance are the tin fields, having an area of 6,250 square miles. There are only a few localities in the whole world where tin is found, or, according to geologists, where it can be found, so that this large field in the antipodes colony may in the course of time, when other longer worked deposits shall have been exhausted, prove to be of universal importance and incalculable benefit to the country wherein it is located. The present value of these deposits are shown in an expert in 1874 of £245,435. We next have the deposits of copper, found over an area of 3,800 square miles. The exports in 1874 were £220,444. And, lastly, of those useful and valuable resources we have the fields of boracite shale, approximated as given at 650 square miles. These would seem to be of considerable richness and great intrinsic value. A ton will, it is said, produce from 150 to 160 gallons of oil, which is equal to the production of 18,000 cubic feet of gas, having an illuminating power equal to 40 candles.
