Recreation mainly consisted of card playing and singing. Some men played musical instruments they brought to the camp. On Saturday night the men stayed up later than the usual curfew of **10:00** p.m. which was in effect every night but Saturday. On Sunday the men usually washed their clothes, cut their hair and sharpened their tools (grinded their axes on the grindstones).

Few went home for the Christmas holidays (usually just the cook and those men who had families of their own). Those who remained in camp had Christmas Day off and worked during the rest of what we normally call our Christmas Holiday.
