



School board inaugural

John McCullough, Simcoe County Board of Education trustee for Midland, was sworn into office at last week's inaugural meeting. There were only six new faces on the 21-man board, including those from Flos Township, Elmvale and Wasaga Beach trustee Wendy MacKenzie, who defeated the incumbent Wilf Downer in the December 2 municipal election.

Board gets \$141,600 surprise

Simcoe East MPP Gord Smith did not personally deliver the cheque, but the Simcoe County Board of Education at last week's inaugural meeting accepted it anyway.

The cheque, in the amount of \$141,600, came not only as a surprise, but also six years after the Ministry of Education had promised that the money would be paid to the board.

In 1968, the former Midland-Penetanguishene High School Board hired a firm of architects to draft plans for the construction of a second high school for Midland — before the plans were okayed by the Ontario Municipal Board or the Ministry of Education. Considerable expenses were incurred.

When the Simcoe County Board of Education was formed, the plans for a new school were scrapped. Instead an addition to Midland Secondary School was planned.

The province deducted the amount of the former board's debt, approximately \$150,000, from its grant to the board for the addition to MSS.

At that time, the board felt it unreasonable to expect the taxpayers to be saddled with a debt incurred by another board.

"I'd almost given up on it," said Midland trustee John McCullough.

The money will be put in the board's capital account.

Frank Prothero heads Simcoe Board again

Frank Prothero, Simcoe County Board of Education trustee from Tottenham, returned for a second one-year term as chairman of the board at last week's inaugural meeting.

Re-elected as vice-chairman was Bill Brown of Orillia.

In his address to the meeting, Prothero remarked

that the board had a "tendency to dwell on money matters which is quite in order, but the present turn-down in the economy, which in my opinion is just beginning, should level off our need for new and additional buildings."

He expressed the hope that the board in 1975 "will be able to evaluate the more basic, or human, side of responsibilities," referring to the board's studies in special education, moral education, and what is referred to by some as the proliferation of courses in secondary schools.

Board of Education to buy three new school buses

The Simcoe County Board of Education authorized the purchase of three school buses at its inaugural meeting last week.

According to the past practice of replacing the board-owned buses on an

eight-year cycle where the vehicles' condition warranted such replacement, the board committee felt it would be necessary to replace two buses. In addition, the growth being experienced in the expanded town of

Wasaga Beach and surrounding areas indicate the need for an additional bus, the report stated.

The new buses will most likely see service in the Collingwood and Wasaga Beach area, where the board operates its own buses.
