Centenary head selected

Mr. Harold Ball died on January 7, 1975 at the Penetanguishene General Hospital after a brief illness. He was 53 years old.

Born in Midland on June 7, 1922 to Fred and Vera Ball he spent most of his life in this area. He was an engineer at Beck's Box Factory for nine years and for the last ten years he worked at Bay Mills. He was also a school trustee S.S. no. 23, R.R. 2 Penetanguishene for approximately eight years.

Funeral services were held at St. Ann's Church on January 10, 1975 with Father L. Dignard presiding. Burial took place at St. Ann's Cemetery, Penetanguishene.
