

## Town police

As of last Friday there was little to report from the Town Police office.  
In fact only one incident, a two vehicle accident on Poyntz Street.  
A total of \$450 in damages was reported by the police as a result of the accident involving vehicles driven by Leonard Quesnelle of 190 Robert Street West and Anita Brunelle of Concession 16 in Tiny Township.  
Police charged Quesnelle with impaired driving and excess alcohol.

### Two car crash

A two car accident last Friday on Church Street near Burke is still under investigation. Two Penetanguishene men, 31-year-old Paul King of 47 Peel Street and 28-year-old James Burt of 27 Dufferin Street were involved in the accident.  
Damage to King's car was set at \$150 by the Penetanguishene Police. Burt's vehicle sustained \$200 in damages.  
No injuries were reported by police.

### One accident, three charges

A 23-year-old Penetanguishene man faces three charges following a car-truck collision on Main Street on Saturday morning.  
Gary Hachey of Fuller Avenue, RR 1 Penetanguishene was charged with driving without insurance, not having an operators license, and starting from a parked position not in safety.  
The half-ton truck driven by Hachey sustained only \$10. in damage, but the car driven by 51-year-old William Maxwell of Midland had an estimated \$300 in damages according to Town Police.

## OPP report

### Perkinsfield man charged

Last Saturday just after noon two cars were involved in an accident on Simcoe County Road 25 one half mile west of County Road 6. Police report that a vehicle driven by David John Krochko, 19, of Seventh Street in Midland, suffered \$500 damage after it collided with a car driven by John Baird, 77, of Perkinsfield. The Baird car had only \$25 damage. Police report the accident occurred after one car crossed over the middle of the road striking the other. Baird has been charged with failure to share the roadway.

### No injuries on icy roads

Also, Saturday afternoon at 1:40 on County Road 26 near County Road 6 there was another two car accident, this one involving only minor damage and no charges. Cars driven by William W. Carson, 30, of Woodland Drive in Midland, and Patricia A. Brunelle, 28, or RR 3 Penetanguishene, each received \$100 damage. Police report that road conditions were bad at the time and laid no charges. There were no injuries.

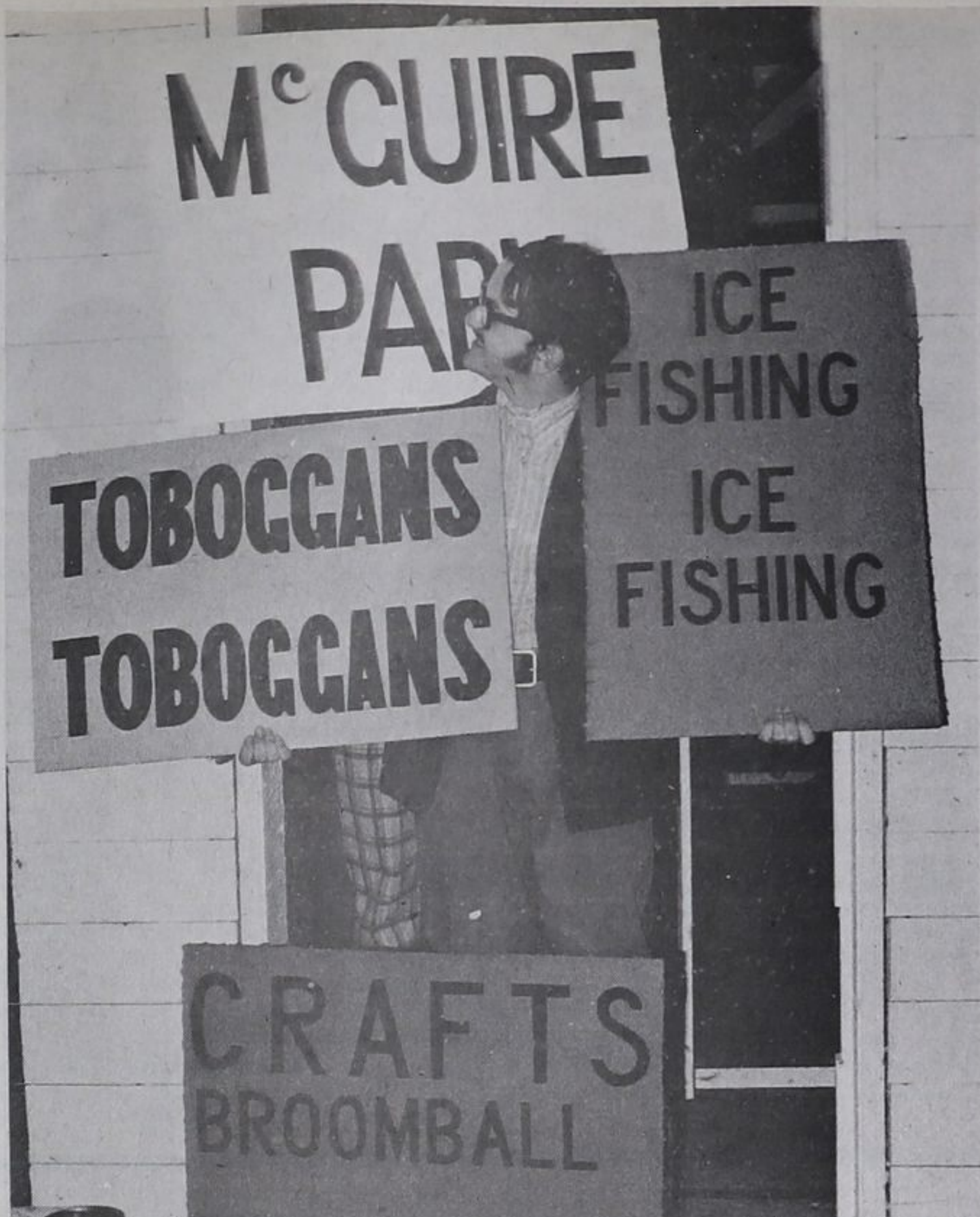
## This week's PGH births

## Obituary:

### Arthur Bellisle dies at 66

Arthur Bellisle died suddenly in Penetanguishene on February 6, 1975. He was 66 years old.  
Born in Penetanguishene on April 7, 1908, to John and Clemence Bellisle (both deceased). He spent his lifetime in this area where he owned and operated a Butcher Shop for over 50 years.  
Funeral services were held at St. Ann's Church on February 8, 1975, with Father J. Harrington presiding. Burial took place at St. Ann's Cemetery, Penetanguishene.  
Pallbearers were Blaise Marchildon, Arthur Patenaude, Leonard, Norman, Clifford and Roy Bellisle.  
Mr. Bellisle is survived by his wife, Mrs. Alida (Quesnelle) Bellisle, son Larry, Daughters Rita (Mrs. Russell Wright) all of Penetanguishene, Germaine (Mrs. Jack Ambeau) of Bramalea.

## Council footnotes

Council approved a debenture of \$56,176 to pay off the remaining costs compiled as the result of the construction of sanitary sewers last year.

The debenture is to be repaid by 1995 at the rate of 9.04 per cent interest.

The parks, recreation and arena boards were guaranteed direct representation at the town council level with the passage of a bylaw which requires that a member of council be chairman of each of these boards.

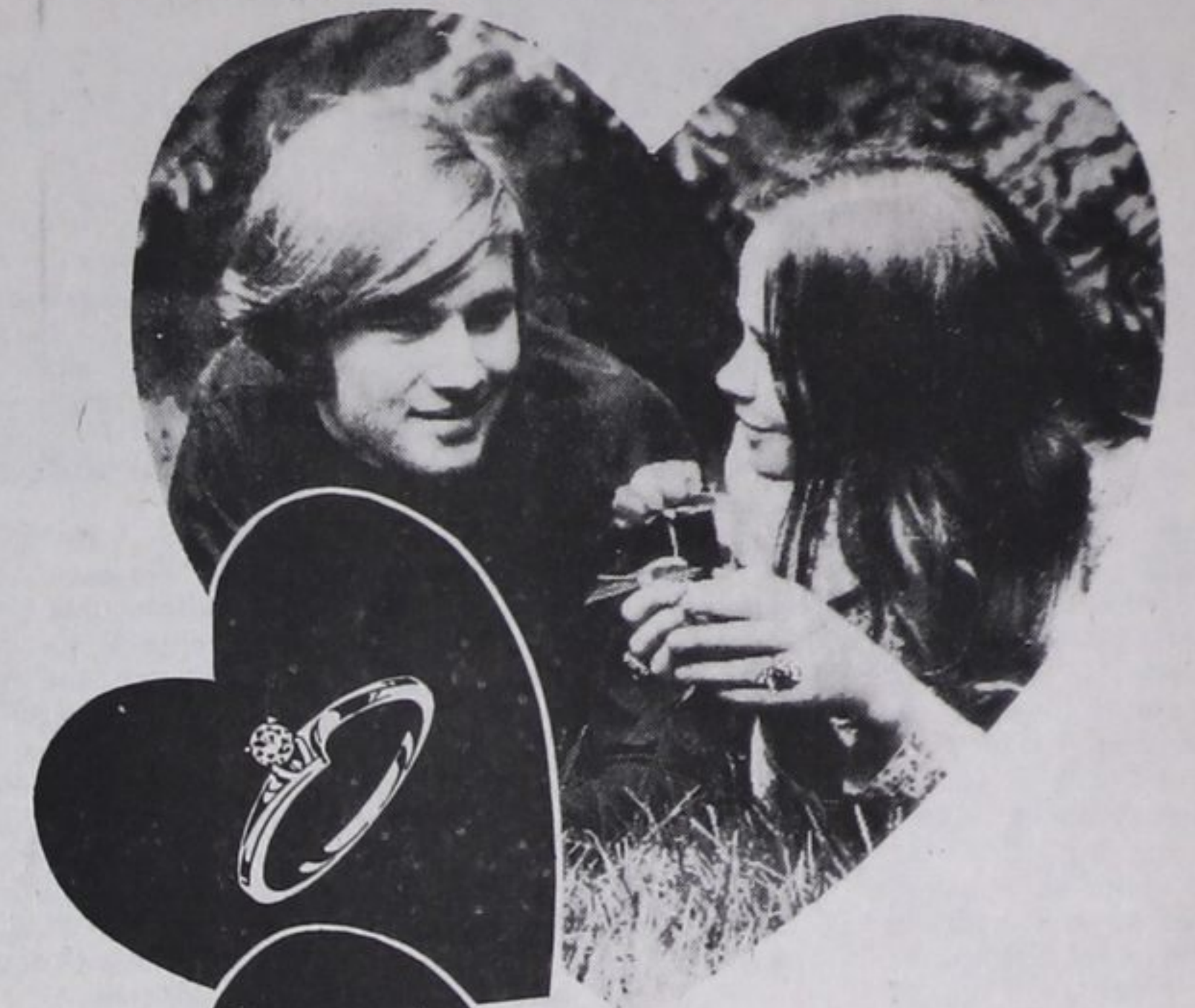
The purpose of this rule change is to make sure a member of council will be available to explain the actions of these boards. In other words they will be on the receiving end of any flack or praise directed at the three boards.

Previously a person not on council could chair any of these three boards. Under the old setup if council wanted to examine the operation of any of the three boards a representative of the board was often not available to speak because councillors were not required to be chairmen.

The chairman of the amalgamated board, which presides over the activities of all three boards still is not allowed to be a member of council.

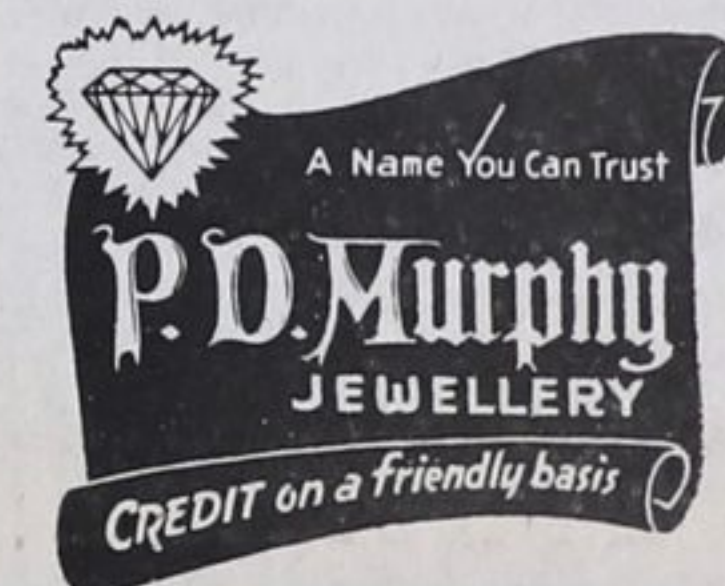
Ken Tannahill will chair the recreation committee, Ron Bellisle gets the parks committee, and Francis St. Amant heads the arena committee.
