To the Ontario Municipal Board by the Corporation of the Township of Tiny for approval of a by-law to regulate land use passed pursuant to Section 35 of the Planning Act

NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO THE Ontario Municipal Board by the Corporation of the Township of Tiny for approval of a By-Law to regulate land use passed pursuant to Section 35(21) of the Planning Act.

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Tiny intends to apply to the Ontario Municipal Board pursuant to the provisions of Section 35(21) of the Planning Act for approval of By-Law No. 35-74 passed on the 26th day of September, 1974.

The following is a summary and explanation of By-Law 35-74 which amends By-Law 1530 which is the comprehensive Restricted Area By-Law affecting land in the Township of Tiny.

The Council of the Township of Tiny deems it desirable to further amend the provisions of By-Law 1530 as amended, said By-Law being passed the 4th day of November 1966, and,

Whereas the Ontario Municipal Board heard the said By-Law 1530 as amended and issued their Board Order P.2759, dated June 5th, 1972 conditionally approving said By-Law 1530 as amended.

The Council of the Township of Tiny further deems it desirable to rezone land which were exempted by said Ontario Municipal Board Order.

By-Law 35-74 is dealing with the Board Order rezoning the lands which were left unzoned and rectifying the sections that were left unapproved. The By-Law conforms to the Official Plan for the Township of Tiny Planning Area.

This By-Law affects land in the Township of Tiny which said properties are described as follows:

- xxi - Concession 20, R.P. 1051, 1084, 1244, 840 and 1371.

The above is an explanation of the provisions of the amendment to the Zoning By-Law. For accurate reference the amendment and the original By-Law Number 1530 should be consulted at the Township Office during regular business hours.

ANY PERSON INTERESTED may, within fourteen (14) days after the date of this notice, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the Township of Tiny notice of his objection to approval of the said by-law, together with a statement of the grounds of such objection.

ANY PERSON wishing to support the application for approval of the By-Law may within fourteen (14) days after the date of this notice send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the Township of Tiny notice of his support of approval of the said by-law together with a request for notice of any hearing that may be held giving also the name and address to which such notice should be given.

THE ONTARIO MUNICIPAL BOARD may approve the said by-law but before doing so it may appoint a time and place when any objection to the by-law will be considered. Notice of any hearing that may be held will be given only to persons who have filed an objection or notice of support and who have left with or delivered to the Clerk undersigned, the address to which notice of hearing is to be sent.

THE LAST DATE FOR FILING OBJECTIONS WILL BE THE 11th DAY OF March, 1975.
