Green is good for you; freeze it



was on sale locally at a price so low it made sense to freeze large quantities of it for future use.

The easiest way to freeze vegetables is to steam blanch them. You can use a dutch oven for this - that's a large double boiler arrangement, the top half of which has a perforated bottom. A tight fitting lid is essential, during the steaming process. If you are lacking in the dutch oven department, you can use a wire basket and a large pot, but keep the bottom of the basket above the water level.

Most cookbooks carry timetables for blanching

vegetables. For broccoli it's five minutes. The vegetable emerges from its sauna a rich and beautiful green. Then it's popped into plastic bags, cooled and frozen.

Vegetables will get more costly, so whenever they're on sale, it's wise to take an advantage. Consider only fresh high quality stuff. You only get out of a freezer what you put in.

Broccoli marries well with cheese, and most kids who aren't keen on the sometimes strong taste will react happily to a cheese sauce and a dusting of bread crumbs.

Or, you can try this broccoli casserole which does well as a main dish. It's economical, and quite impressive.

one pound (or a little less, if it's a lean week) sausage
A generous package of frozen or fresh broccoli
1/2 cup chopped onion
1/4 teaspoon nutmeg
2 eggs beaten
6 tablespoons evaporated milk, or cream, if you're rich.
1/3 cup bread crumbs

salt to taste
Cook the sausage slowly till it's nice and light brown. Combine everything, and pour into a greased casserole.

Bake at 320 degrees for an hour.

If you're the artistic type, you can garnish this with hard boiled eggs or a little pimento.

This is good with last night's left over potatoes, disguised as hash browns. Happy freezing.

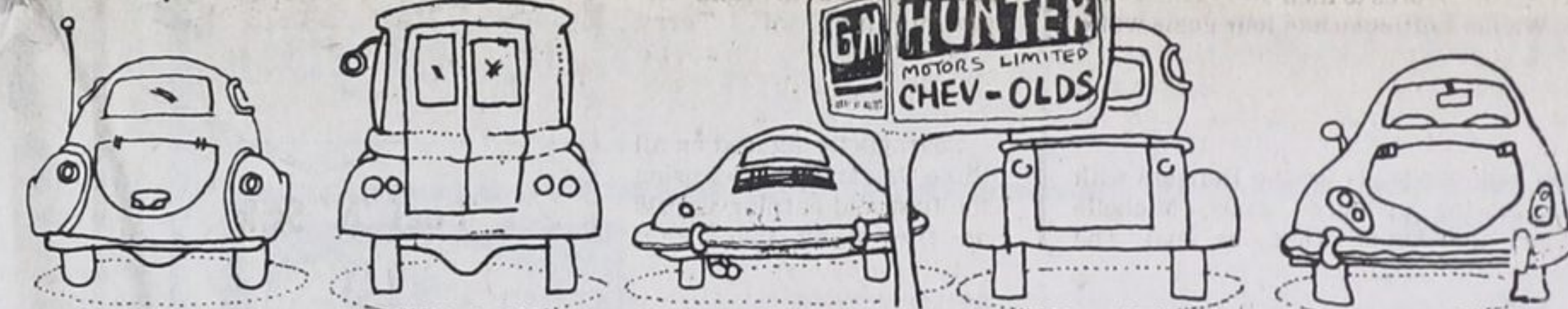
