**Produce Prices...**



Because Canada imports large quantities of fresh produce from the U.S., price changes here for fruit and vegetables generally reflect the corresponding U.S. price patterns. Take onions for example. As our own wholesale supply of onions begins to dwindle in the springtime, the demand pressures for American onions push prices up. During the period between April 14 to 18, wholesale prices of onions at Canada's largest food terminal jumped from \$4.00 a bag to \$8.00. When farmers and brokers can obtain higher prices for their produce the retail value must follow the same upward trend. When there is an oversupply of fresh produce, prices go down. We have experienced this situation lately with the potato glut when a 20-lb. bag sold for nearly the regular price of a 10-lb. bag. There is no magic in produce pricing; supplies larger than demand cause downward trends and vice versa. Mrs. Green is available to talk "Shopping" to groups.
