To Hudson's Bay

Captain transferred to North

After 32 years sailing the waters of Georgian Bay, Penetanguishene-born ship's master Bernard Gravelle will make his first journey to Hudson's Bay next month.

At 48, Gravelle has been appointed western supervisor for the Great Lakes Pilotage Authority — a territory that takes in the port of Churchill, where a good shipping season is perhaps two months because of the heavy ice conditions.

There is one pilot working out of Churchill, and the major part of Gravelle's work will be to supervise 46 pilots in District 2, which takes in the area from Port Weller west to Sarnia.

For the past seven years, Gravelle has acted as liaison and marine officer with the St. Lawrence Seaway Authority.

He started working on the lakes in 1943 as a deck hand, and in 1945 joined the Quebec and Ontario Transportation Co. where he stayed for 23 years. He earned his master's papers in 1951 and got his first ship, the Shelter Bay, four years later.

He's been ashore now for seven years, and that's taking him off to the Canadian north. A father of five, Captain Gravelle makes his home in Thorod.

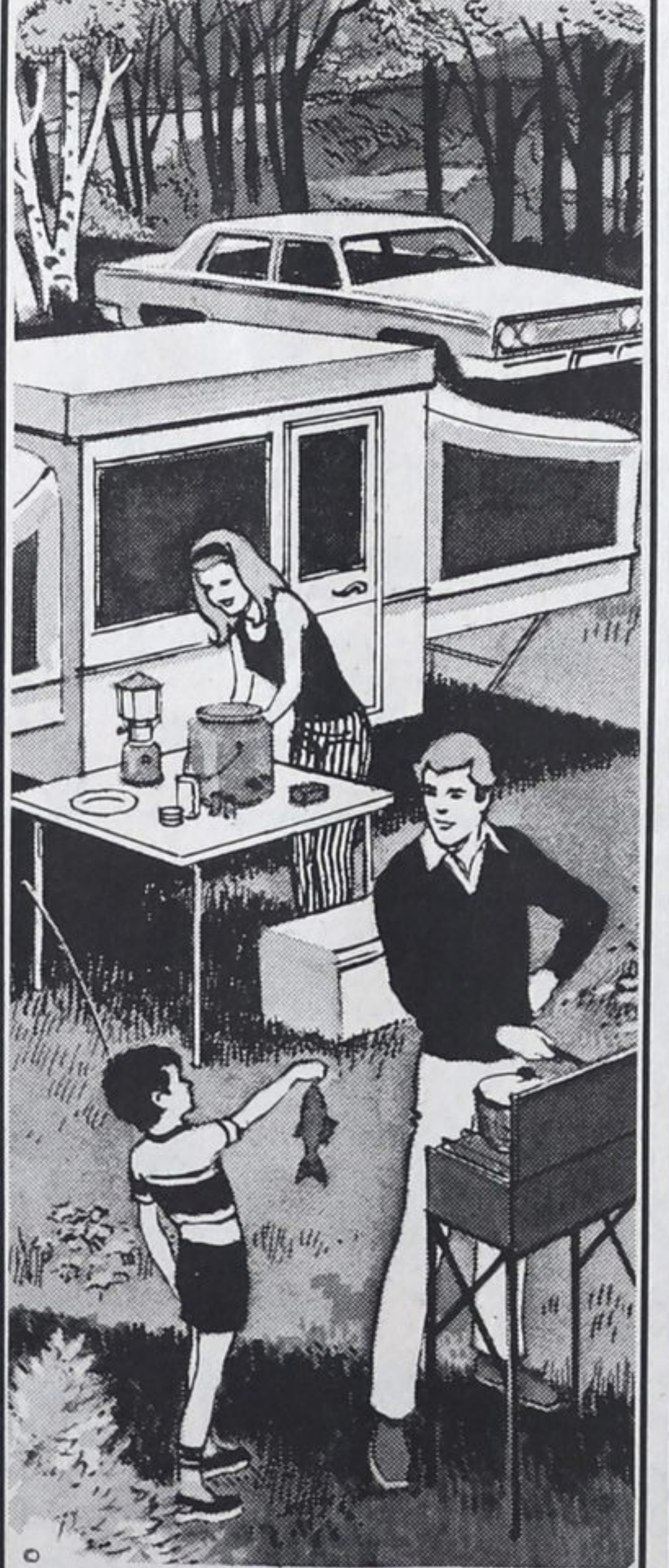
