

## Consumers to see new "Best Before" label

Competition

freshness of products reaching the consumer, a new regulation has been put in to effect under the Food and Drugs Act. As of March 1, all processorprepacked consumer packages of meat and other perishable food products began carrying a "Best Before" date.

If you found in the meat counter the notation "Best before Mr 31" on a package, you would regard this as the date for "durable life" of the product. The month is abbreviated to two letters. March will be listed as Mr, April as Al and

June as Jn, etc. It is important to un-'derstand what "durable life" represents. It simply means that it is the date up to which the product can be expected to retain, without appreciable deterioration, its normal wholesomeness, palatability, nutritional value or any other qualities claimed for it by the processor. But this is

under continuous, adequate refrigeration. It does not mean that the product cannot or should not be used after

the date shown. Nor does it mean that up to that date, regardless of the way the product has been kept and stored before or after purchase, there is complete assurance of quality and freshness.

If the "Best Before" date is close at hand, the package should be consumed in the near future, especially when opened. The "durable life" of unopened packages can be extended by immediate freezing.

For the next year meat, poultry and fish products packaged and sold in stores by retailers will carry a packaging date rather than a "durable life" date. But placards at point of sale will indicate for each type of such instore packaged products, what durable life can be expected.

Consumers can now continue to comparison shop, using the date as an extra check on freshness




