Please note the Library will be closed on Good Friday, April 16th and Easter Monday, April 19th.

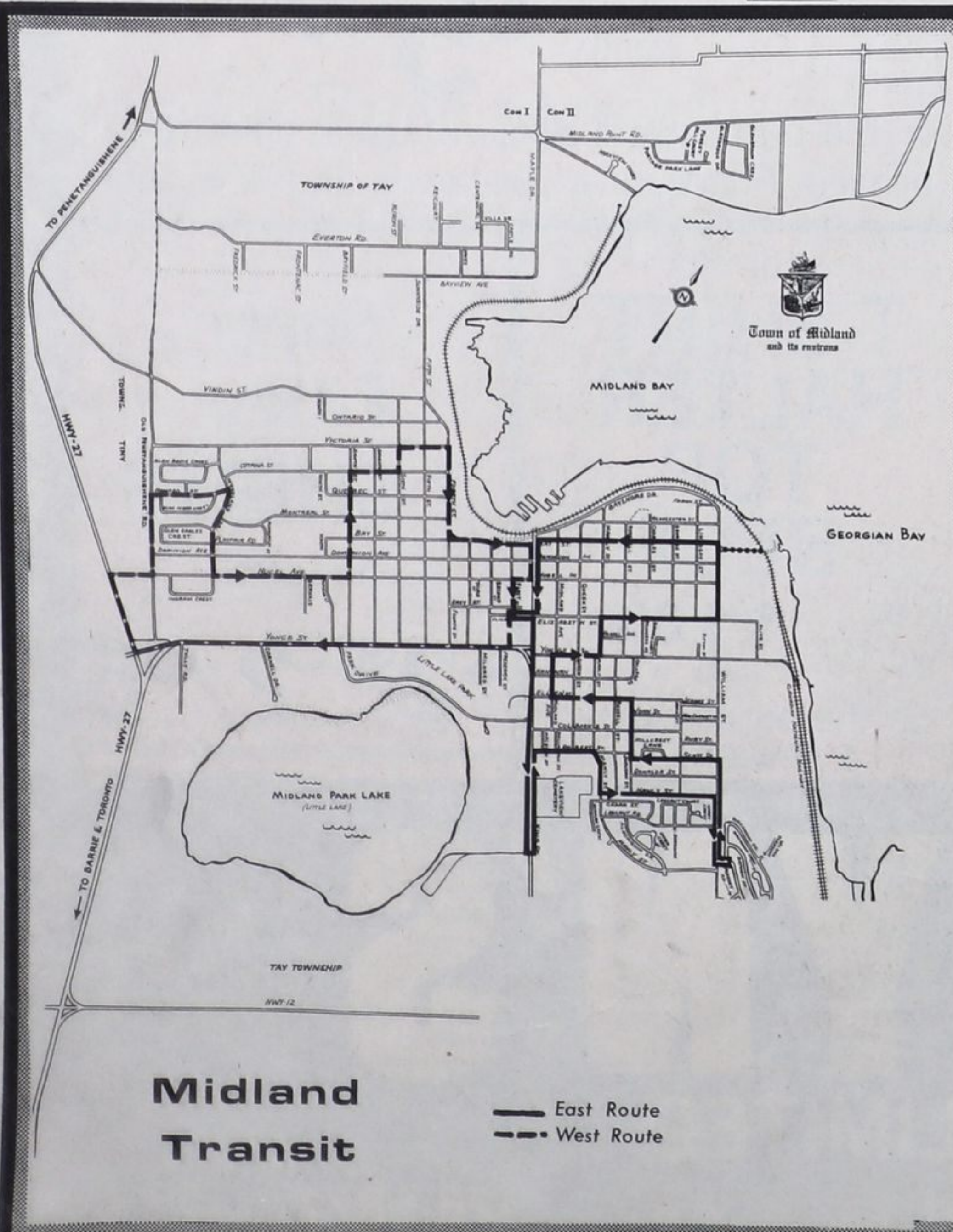

On Monday, April 19th, 1976, the Town of Midland will institute revised transit service. The white and green vehicles, will follow the routes indicated on the accompanying map. The transit vehicles will carry an "EAST" or "WEST" sign corresponding to the route to be followed.
