Sailing school adds program

A new dimension in instructor training will be introduced into the 1976 Sailing School being operated by the Ontario Sailing Association and Georgian College at Lake Rosseau in Muskoka. Commencing June 20, the seven-day event will for the first time include a Racing Clinic which will provide training for those seeking accredition as racing coaches. Candidates must have taught sailing for a minimum of two years and have also demonstrated a high level of racing proficiency. This clinic will also provide training for those who wish to up-grade

The regular Instructor Development Program and the Sailing School, will again be included in the overall program.

their racing skills. Olympic level racers will be a feature of the school.

There are still some vacancies in the Sailing School, in the Racing Clinic and in the Instructor Training Program. The Instructor Development Program is designed for anyone who meets the required qualifications, and who plans to teach sailing. with the major emphasis being on instructor training and development. Training offered to instructor candidates is two-fold, with the primary aim being to offer teaching skills to people who are already accomplished sailors. It also helps to upgrade their sailing proficiency and point out weak areas. Instruction is offered by classroom sessions, by on water practice and by practical on-site teaching experience. At the end of the week the instructor evaluators are able to indicate whether the student instructors have met the requirements necessary for certification.

The purpose of the Sailing School is to offer a fun learning experience to anyone wishing to sail and to provide a live instructional school for instructor candidates. It also enables sailing students to learn from the best instructors in Ontario and to benefit from a low teacherstudent ratio. Students will be separated into 6 categories, ranging from beginner to advanced. with not more than 15 to a

The tuition fee for the Instructors' School is \$150.00 and the same reductions apply for those bringing their own sailboat or power boat. The instructor fee also includes accommmodation and food in lieu of salary.
