



School board to continue evening school program

The Simcoe County Board of Education has approved the continued coordination in the Penetanguishene area of the regular evening school program and the instructional programs of the Penetanguishene Arena, Parks and Recreation Board, and LeCentre d'Activite Francaises, under the St. Joseph's Evening School.

The registration fees for the St. Joseph's Evening School program will be set at the same time as those for the rest of the county.

In November, 1975 the Board approved the formation of a Penetanguishene Community School program to coordinate the programs offered by the Penetanguishene Arena, Parks and Recreation Board, LeCentre d'Activite Francaises and St. Joseph's Evening School.

Over 1100 people enrolled in the 10 week course which began in January and ended in late March. A second session of 12 classes was started in April and will be finished in June.

Those enrolled in the courses come from Penetanguishene, Tiny, Tay and Midland.
