The Georgian Task Force on the Learning Community recently completed phase two of a study prompted by The Learning Society, the report of the Commission on Post-Secondary Education in Ontario.

The southern Georgian Bay area, consisting of Simcoe, Grey, Bruce, and Dufferin counties was selected for the study as being a typical "slice of Ontario" - close to Toronto but not totally dominated by Toronto's educational and cultural life, and having a mixture of urban, small town and rural communities.




## "A Night of Music" presented
