ARC campaign reaches goal

Although tabulations are not yet finalized, organizers of the Huronia Association for the Mentally Retarded May campaign are projecting that their goal has been surpassed.

Campaign chairman Herb De Jong said Monday that by all accounts, volunteers have brought in "a little over" the campaign objective.

Volunteers canvassed industry, households, and businesses during the last two weeks of May in order to raise money for a new facility for the Adult Rehabilitation Centre (ARC) in Midland.

The Ministry of Community and Social Services has agreed to chip in 80 per cent of the total cost of the complex, but the remainder had to be found in the community at large.

Volunteers are being asked to submit their pledge sheet and donations to the campaign committee by June 22.

Hugel and Eighth Street and on into Park.

Cars coming to the Park can enter from Yonge Street only and follow the arrows to the Concert. There is no entrance fee!

At 2:30 p.m. the Gospel Pop Group under the leadership of Mr. Ken Keefe perform and at 3:00 p.m. the Midland Knights, our famous Midland Barber Shop singers, under the direction of Mr. Glen Campbell will entertain. At 3:45 p.m. the Penetanguishene Secondary School band will play followed by the singing and instrumental group from Wyevale - the Caston Family.
