An Orillia building contractor has been fined \$6,000 for contraventions of the Construction Safety

The company, under the registered name of Lankinwoods, pleaded guilty to several charges in provincial court last

Between September 19 to October 10, 1975, the company breached the safety act regulations covering the use of a ramp less than 19" wide, uncovered openings in the floor, absence of guardrails around floor openings and the building perimeters and an improperly constructed platform used at a height of more than eight feet.

The company was fined \$1,000 for contravention of the act and an addtional \$1,000 for not complying with an order issued by a Ministry of Labour Construction Safety Inspector to correct the problems.

Early in 1976 the company was again fined \$2,000 for similar offences. Another \$2,000 was levied for failing to correct the hazardous conditions.

The site of the construction is a residential project on Lankin Boulevard in Orillia.
