Credit counselling service

Receives grant of \$18,200 from province

A provincial government grant of approximately \$18,200 has been granted to the Credit Counselling Service serving the Simcoe-Georgian Bay region. In announcing the grant, the Honourable James Taylor, Minister of

Community and Social Services, pointed out the advantages of the counselling service: "The availability of credit tends to draw some people in over their heads," Mr. Taylor explained. "Counselling strives to arrange orderly

payment of debt to prevent wage garnishee and subsequent job loss with its negative effect on the family." This year almost \$600,000, representing 60 per cent of counselling agencies budgets, has been allocated to 26 credit

counselling agencies in Ontario. These agencies work on a program of finding the most satisfactory solution to an individual's indebtedness and assisting the person and family in better managing their financial affairs.

Community involvement is important to the success of these programs, as 40 per cent of counselling agencies' budgets come from the community through a variety of contributors, and most day-to-day operations are handled by

social welfare, education, consumer, labour and other community groups. Information on credit counselling in Simcoe County can be obtained from the Credit Counselling Service of Simcoe-Georgian Bay at Box 922, Barrie.
