A bit early yet for hunting for salmon

Some professional anglers are already venturing onto Lake Ontario to track the coho and chinook salmon. They are preparing for the fall salmon hunt, but it's a bit early yet.

However, by mid-August the salmon should be congregating in the general Toronto and Port Credit area. Then those west coast lunkers will begin biting lures.

In a recent exploratory trip with special sonar tracking gear, Ministry of Natural Resources staff recorded many large fish swimming about at depths of 25 to 35 feet below schools of forage fish. These are undoubtedly salmon which will eventually return to

the Credit River area later in the summer.

Lake fishing for these salmon should begin in mid-August and continue until late September in the general Port Credit area.

In the spring of 1975, the Ministry stocked 120,000 salmon smolt in the mid sections of the Credit River. The survivors from this stocking will be returning to the Credit this fall. Last year's catch of coho jacks — males returning to the river a year before they should — was very low, an indication that the 1976 fall return of adults might be a poor one.

In the past, these runs of jacks served as general indicators of the size of

the coming year's adult run. However, predictions have gone wrong before and the recent trackings of large fish out in the lake suggest that a large run might be forthcoming.

In the spring of 1975 the Ministry also stocked

25,000 coho in the Humber River and an experimental planting of 44,000 in the Don River. It

will be interesting to see what comes back to these rivers, especially the Don.

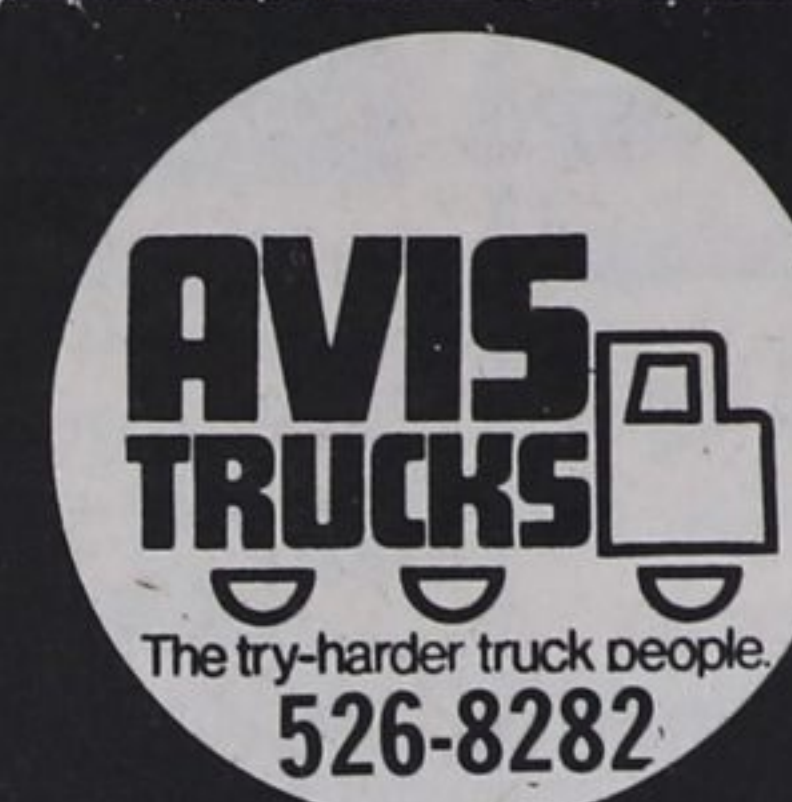

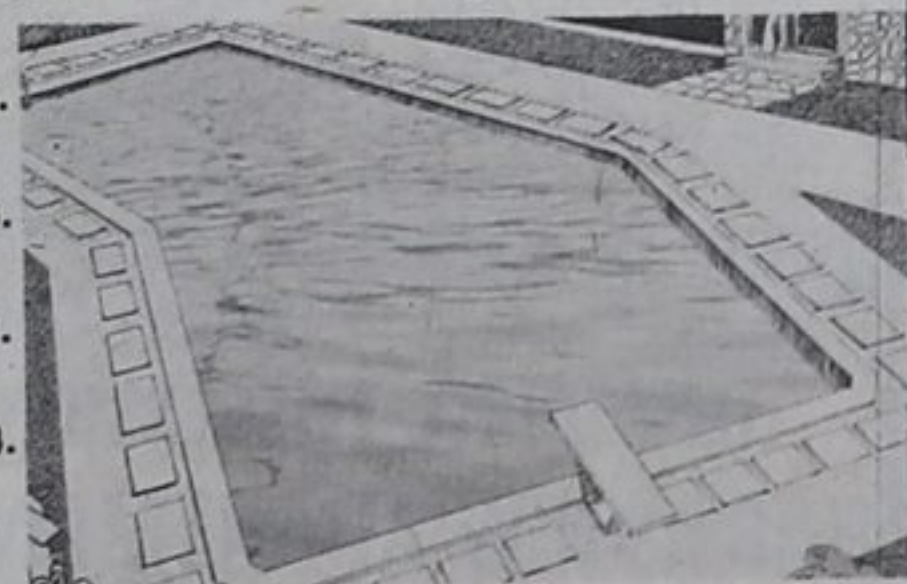

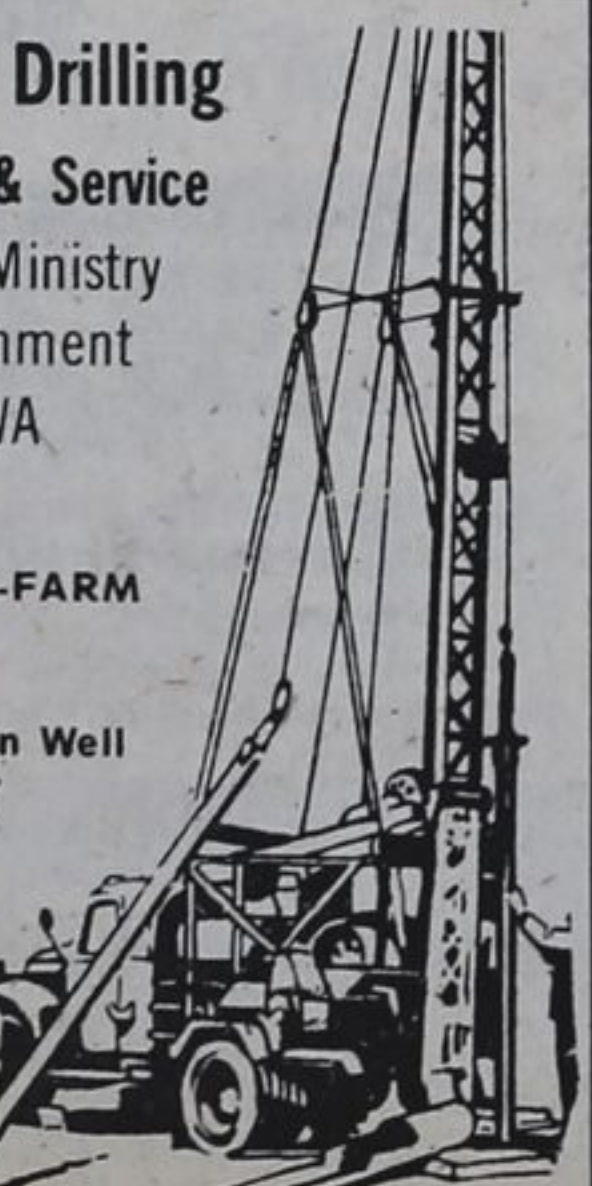
