The work consists generally of: The supplying of materials for and the installation of approximately 1200' of 8" diameter sanitary sewers, 4850' of 12" to 24" diameter storm sewers, including catchbasins, manholes and service connections, 7400' of mostly 12" and 10" diameter water mains, including valves, hydrants and service connections.

Regrading and rebuilding existing roadwork, complete with curb and gutter, driveways, sodding of boulevards and ancillary works; approx. 2800 feet of 32 feet wide asphalt pavement, 4500 feet of 26 feet wide asphalt pavement.

Resurfacing existing asphalt pavements, including new concrete curb and gutter, driveways, sodding of boulevards and ancillary works: approximately 550 feet of 26 feet wide pavement.

Construction of approximately 3200 feet of concrete sidewalk, 5 feet wide.

Construction of street lighting for all streets including removal of 19 existing light fixtures, placing 22 mercury-vapour light fixtures on existing poles and 18 high-pressure sodium fixtures on new concrete poles, complete with all underground and overhead wiring and controls.
