The school is open to any boy, girl or adult in the area.



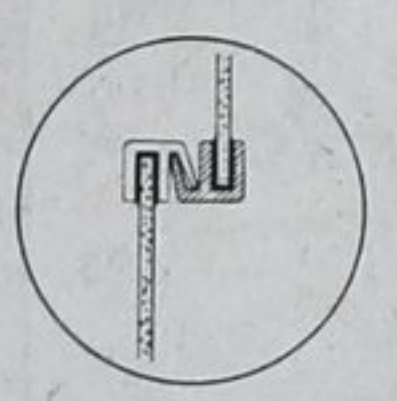




Double insulation by wool pile weatherstrip on both sides of glass sash.
