Take-a-break

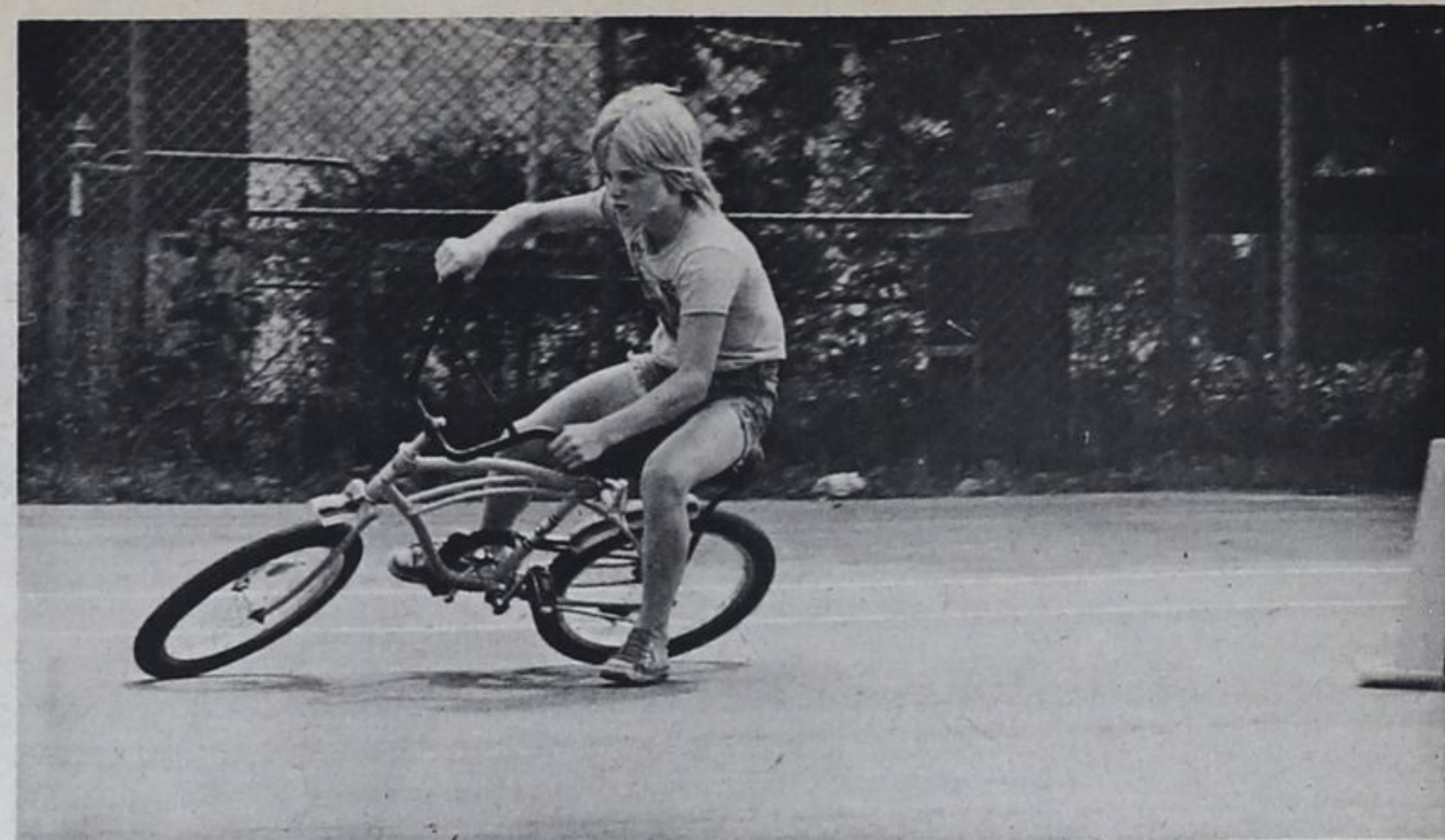

SIMCOE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION SCHOOL BUS ROUTES FOR SEPT. 1976

For pupils attending the following schools: Huron Park, Bayview, Regent, Corpus Christi, St. Joseph's, Medonte West (Hillsdale), Parkview, Wyevale, Wyebridge, Waubaushene, Midland and Penetanguishene Secondary Schools. All routes remain the same as last year except for the following changes:

Regent

Bayberry Estates students formerly on Route 372, now Route 351 as follows: Beginning at Hwy 12, north on Conc 6, to County Road 23, east to Conc 7, north to 5/6 sideroad, return to County Road 23, west to Conc 6, south to 20/21 sideroad, (Medonte) west to Conc 5, north to Hwy 12, west to Midland Sec. Evening Run: return to Conc 6, and Hwy 12 continue as a.m.

Parkview

Route No. 336E
New route as follows: Beginning at Hwy 27, west on County Road 25 to Conc 2 o/s south to Con 9, return to County Road 25, west to Beach Road, north to Conc 11, east via Conc 11 Golf Course Road and Vinden Street to Midland Schools.

Wyevale

Route No. 333E cancelled

Route No. 335E

Route Description: Beginning at Conc 2 o/s west on Conc 8, to County Road 6, north to County Road 25, west to Beach Road, south to Conc 5, east to 18/19 sideroad, north to Conc 6, east to 11/12 sideroad, south to Wyevale and school.

Route No. 339E

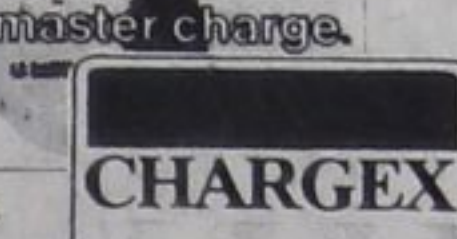
