Cranberry project

of Penetang.

by E. Lorraine Orr A project of interest at this time of year has been in progress all summer, conducted by the Mohawk Indians of the Gibson Reserve, situated just north of Port Severn on Highway 69. At this commercial cranberry bog they hope to produce 150,000 to 200,000 pounds of prime cranberries this

This undertaking was started in 1969 with government financial assistance and a lot of determination by the people of the reserve under the direction of Tom (Bud) Rennie. whose father is a fullblooded Mohawk Indian. The primary objective was to provide jobs for the Reserve residents. Cranberry vines were imported from Wisconsin and planted, fertilized, weeded and irrigated for four years until the first crop was harvested. This year's crop will be the biggest yet. Besides the three year-round workers on the project, some 10 or 12 Gibson Indians will work at harvesting and processing it.

The Gibson people like to sell small packages of cranberries to visitors to the plantation. To reach the plant take Highway 69 to about three-quarters of a mile north of the Muskoka River and look for the cranberry growers
