The grade seven students will take part in a course entitled "Learning to be Human" which will concentrate on the individual, his view of himself and his ability to get along with others.

In grade eight the course will continue to look at developing selfawareness, growing up with others, and friend-

The students will then move onto sexual maturity, dating. puberty, maturation and the birth process.

Simcoe County was chosen by the government as one of four test areas for the project. An on-line computer

system will be installed in the county building in the social services department which will be tied in to a computer system at units in Ontario.

The purpose of setting any of the other depart- said Tucker. up such a system would be to determine the level of social services required in the province.

Social services administrator Gordon Tucker is in favor of the project and tried to eliminate, any queries the councillors had concerning the installation of a computer in Simcoe County.
