terior supporting posts, and to brighten empty corners.  
Everything comes from Gray's greenhouse where he and his staff perform such annual miracles as raising thousands of geraniums from seed each year. "We have found this cheaper than keeping the old ones over the winter."

The community thrust of Inco's Greening of Sudbury program was obvious as Gray outlined the special projects undertaken by his department. "We encourage school tours, and in fact grow special plants just to please the kids, like bananas and pineapple. We donate trees for folks to plant in their gardens, and annually plant 25 thousand trees ourselves. We also operate radio hot-lines for people with horticultural questions, and we answer about 30 phone calls a day at our greenhouse, from people with planting problems. And we loan out plants for special events, and help schools to establish greenhouses."

Gray describes himself as a most fortunate man. "I don't have a job," he says, displaying his calloused hands. "I'm paid for working at my hobby."
