Appointment For Hearing

The Ontario Municipal Board hereby appoints Monday, the 15th day of November, 1976, at the hour of eleven o'clock (local time) in the forenoon at the Township Office, in the Hamlet of Moonstone, for the hearing of all parties interested in supporting or opposing this application.

If you do not attend and are not represented at this hearing, the Board may proceed in your absence and you will not be entitled to any further notice of the proceedings.

In the event the decision is reserved, persons taking part in the hearing may request a copy of the decision from the presiding Board Member. Such decision will be mailed to you when available.

Explanatory Note

Of The Proposed By-Law No. 1266 and Amendment No. 1277

The purpose of the proposed By-law No. 1266 is to regulate the use of land and the character, location and use of buildings and structures in the Township of Medonte.

It is the opinion of the Planning Board and Council for the Corporation of the Township of Medonte that By-law Number 1266 should be further amended by enacting By-law Number 1277. The purpose of the proposed By-law Number 1277 is to resolve objections raised by By-law Number 1266.

The provisions of the proposed By-laws will apply through the corporate limits of the Township of Medonte and after the approval of the By-laws by the Ontario Municipal Board, no land shall be used and no building or structure shall be erected, altered or used in any manner except in conformity with the provisions of the proposed By-laws.

However, notwithstanding the foregoing statement, the By-laws will not apply to prevent or hinder the continued use of any land, building or structure, which on the day of the passing of the such By-law was legally used or erected for any purpose prohibited by the proposed By-law, so long as it continues to be used for that purpose.
