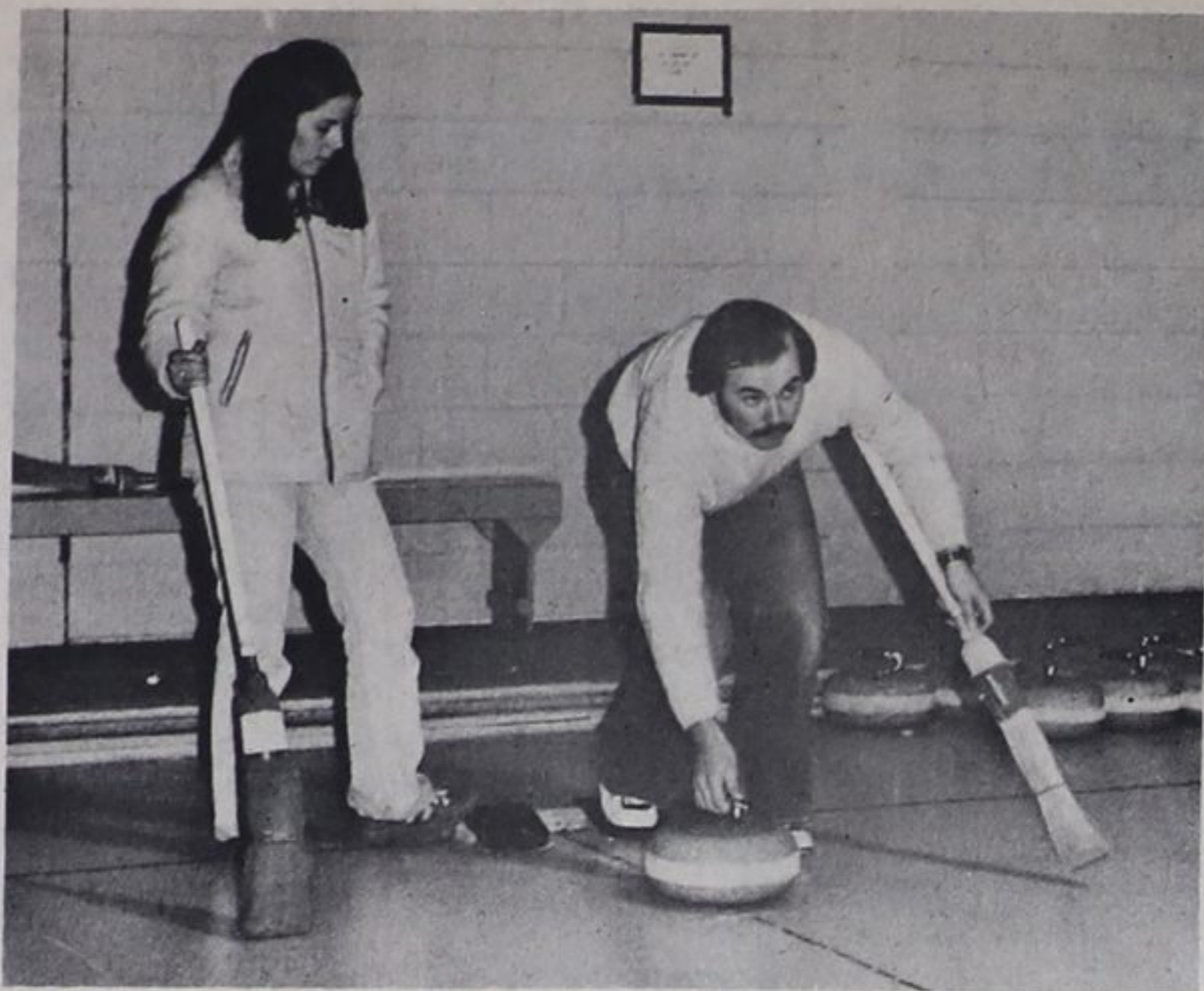

Trustees attend workshop

Three members of the Simcoe County Roman Catholic Separate School Board attended the recent Family Life Workshop, organized by the Simcoe County Unit of the Ministry of Health.

Trustees Healey, Quilty and Eagan and Superintendent of Schools Bolger reported to last week's board meeting that if the program is to succeed it must teach moral values. Their impression was that the clinical approach is not enough.

The board listened to a review of the Ontario Student Record Cards from Director of Education Macdonald. Mr. Macdonald explained that although the system was actually implemented at the elementary level in 1948, it did not become compulsory until 1960.

The cards, which are a record of the student's progress and activities, follow the student from school to school. The folders must be kept for a period of 70 years by the last school a student attends.

Trustee Marchand had attended an Urban Policy Workshop which placed special emphasis on the Tiny-Tay area. He said that by planning together, Tiny, Tay, Midland and Penetang would probably avoid the pitfalls of many other areas.
