Selecting corn seed

November is usually the time farmers start shopping for next year's corn seed. There are a great many varieties offered by an increasing number of companies. Hybrid corn should be

selected first on its heat unit rating. In North Simcoe this is around 2600. The next consideration is the type of hybrid. Is it a single cross, double cross, three way cross or modified cross? Single crosses are usually considered better for a grain corn system.


