

Voting

At poll six it was Lomas 116, Farrow 63, and Lomas took poll seven 252 to 139. At poll eight it was close, with 103 votes going to Lomas, and 99 votes going to Farrow. Lomas won the advance poll 47 to

22, and the Georgian Manor poll, 46 to 8. In the race for the six council seats, at poll one, Mary Rogers topped the poll, Ron Bellisle came in second, Ken Tannahill was third, Bay Baker was

fourth, Frances St. Amant was fifth, and Hubert Charlebois was sixth. At poll two, Baker came out on top, Bellisle was second, Rogers third, St. Amant fourth, Hubert

Charlebois fifth and Tannahill sixth. At poll three it was Rogers first, St. Amant second, Hubert Charlebois was fourth, and Baker was fifth. St. Amant took poll five, with Bellisle second, Rogers third, Baker fourth, Tannahill fifth, and Hubert Charlebois sixth. At poll eight it was a three way tie for first spot, with Tannahill, Bellisle and Baker each getting 126 votes. Rogers was fourth, St. Amant

four, while Ron Bellisle and Mary Rogers tied for the second spot. St. Amant was fourth, Hubert Charlebois was fifth, and Baker was sixth. St. Amant took poll five, with Bellisle second, Rogers third, Baker fourth, Tannahill fifth, and Hubert Charlebois sixth. At poll eight it was a three way tie for first spot, with Tannahill, Bellisle and Baker each getting 126 votes. Rogers was fourth, St. Amant

and Tannahill were tied for the fourth spot. Hubert Charlebois and Eric Rankin were tied for the sixth spot. At poll seven, it was St. Amant on top, Rogers second, Bellisle third, Baker fourth, Tannahill fifth, and Hubert Charlebois sixth. At poll eight it was a three way tie for first spot, with Tannahill, Bellisle and Baker each getting 126 votes. Rogers was fourth, St. Amant

was fifth, and Hubert Charlebois was sixth. In the advance poll, St. Amant came out on top, Rogers was second, Tannahill was third, Hubert Charlebois was fourth, Baker was fifth, and Bellisle was sixth. At Georgian Manor, St. Amant again came out on top, with Rogers second, Baker and Hubert Charlebois tied for third, and Bellisle and Tannahill tied for fifth.

In the final standings, Rogers was in first place, Bellisle took second, St. Amant was third, Tannahill was fourth, Baker was fifth, Hubert Charlebois sixth, Eric Rankin was seventh, Don Charlebois eighth and Bryan Byng ninth. In the race for Water and Light Commission, at poll one, Martin Marchildon came first with 152, Gilbert Robillard was second with 151, and Pia Brunelle was third with

FILM FRANCAIS: A l'affiche ce soir, à 8h00, un film de genre drame politique intitulé "ETAT DE SIEGE" pour adultes.

Un haut-fonctionnaire américain, Philip Michael Santore, est retrouvé assassiné dans une voiture abandonnée dans une rue de la capitale d'un état d'Amérique du Sud. Une journée de deuil national est décrétée.

Santore avait été enlevé, quelques jours auparavant, par une organisation terroriste dont le gouvernement interdit qu'on prononce le nom. Ces terroristes comptaient rendre cet otage si les autorités acceptaient de libérer un certain nombre de prisonniers appartenant à leur mouvement révolutionnaire. En attendant la réponse officielle, Santore est interrogé: il se révèle qu'il est un technicien de la police chargé d'enseigner aux policiers locaux les méthodes les plus modernes de répression et de torture.

Dans d'autres pays d'Amérique latine, sous couvert de l'A.I.D. (organisation censée aider au développement des pays sous-développés), Santore avait, par son action, renforcé le pouvoir des régimes les plus autoritaires, conseillant souvent aux policiers de jouer les provocateurs. On pouvait penser que le gouvernement allait céder quand un coup de filet permit à la police d'arrêter certains des militants les plus importants du mouvement terroriste. Dès lors, le gouvernement décide de ne plus donner suite aux pourparlers engagés avec les terroristes. Santore sait qu'il va mourir. Après vote des militants terroristes il est exécuté.



La qualité de la réalisation et de l'interprétation - prix Louis Delluc - ne saurait nous inciter à l'approbation de la violence et du meurtre, quelle qu'en soit la forme ou l'origine, mais elle nous impose plus fortement une appréciation objective d'un aspect de la politique des Etats-Unis en Amérique latine et une large ouverture aux problèmes d'un monde lointain et mal connu, en état de résistance.




