Town of Midland Schedule "A" To By-Law No. 76-21

1. Seventh Street from Victoria Street to Ontario Street;
2. Eighth Street from Victoria Street to Ontario Street;
3. Ninth Street from Victoria Street to Ontario Street;
4. Penetanguishene Road from the North boundary of the Town of Midland to the South boundary of the Town of Midland;
5. Ontario Street from Ninth Street to the West boundary of the Town of Midland;
6. Victoria Street from the East limit of Registered Plan 1512 to a point 400 feet East therefrom;
7. Montreal Street from the East limit of Registered Plan 1512, East to the West limit of Eighth Street;
8. Bay Street from the East limit of Registered Plan 1512, East to the West limit of Ninth Street;
9. Dominion Avenue from the East limit of Registered Plan 1512 to a point 600 feet East therefrom;
10. Ottawa Street from the East limit of Registered Plan 1512, East to the West limit of Ninth Street.

Purpose and Effect of Restricted Area By-Law No. 76-21

The purpose of By-law No. 76-21 is to prohibit the construction of buildings on streets that are unopened and/ or where no municipal services exist.

The effect of By-law No. 76-21 prevents the issuing of Building Permits by the Municipality on the streets listed in Schedule "A" to the By-law.
