YMCA tax service for seniors

The YMCA Tax Service is making a concerted effort this year to assist as many area pensioners as possible to complete their Application For Guaranteed Income Supplement.

"In our view this is such an important matter that all of our workers have been given special training by the Old Age Security department, which operates the Guaranteed Income Supplement program," reports "Y" Tax Services Manager, Lloyd Skeaff "Anyone who wants free advice or assistance is welcome to come to our office or to telephone us. We are very anxious to help area pensioners to avoid an extremely upsetting experience which happened to a great many of pensioners last spring. their April pension cheques. That is why this year we are emphasizing that we will be offering help in completing the Application."

The Application For Guaranteed Income Supplement is critically important to senior citizens. It can affect as much as 50 per cent of their monthly income. If a pensioner fails to complete and return the Application, his or her monthly pension cheque may be reduced drastically without a word of explanation.

Anyone wishing information or help may visit or telephone the "Y" Tax Service office. The officers are located in Barrie at Trinity Anglican Church Parish Hall, in Midland at St. Paul's United Church, and in Orillia at the YMCA.
