spring sale

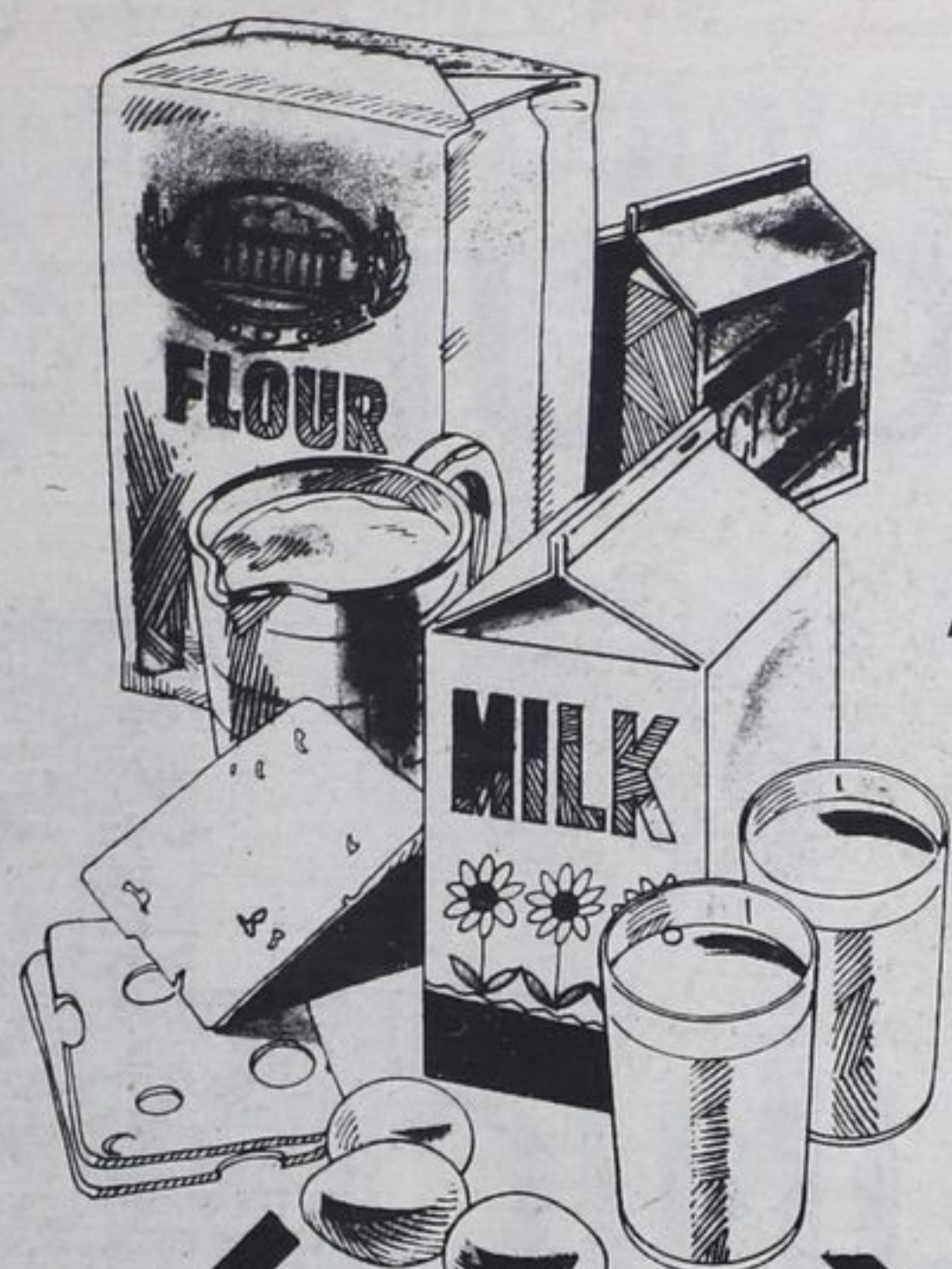
The students of Waubashene/Fesserton Public School are planning a spring auction sale to be held at Waubashene Public School on April 23, 1977.
