The lecture, by Fred Prescod of the Royal Botanical Gardens, attracted a standing-room-only audience of library users and horticultural society members.

The event was an excellent example of the cooperation now being practiced throughout the province in which several agencies work together to bring worthwhile programs to towns and cities which might not otherwise be able to attract them.

In this case the Royal Botanical Gardens, the Georgian Bay Regional

Library System, the Outreach Ontario program of the Ministry of Culture and Recreation, the Penetanguishene Library and the horticultural society were all involved in arranging the program. It was one in a series of eight lectures now being given by Prescod at libraries in the Georgian Bay Region.
