Talk on Canadian art in Penetang tonight

An introductory lecture on the subject of Canadian Art is scheduled for Wednesday evening, June 29th, at seven o'clock at Georgian College, Lorne Street, Penetang. The lecture will be given by Kay Woods who has specialized in the study of Canadian Art for a number of years.
