The regular placements are an increase over the month of May, reports Student Manpower Director Sonya Mount,

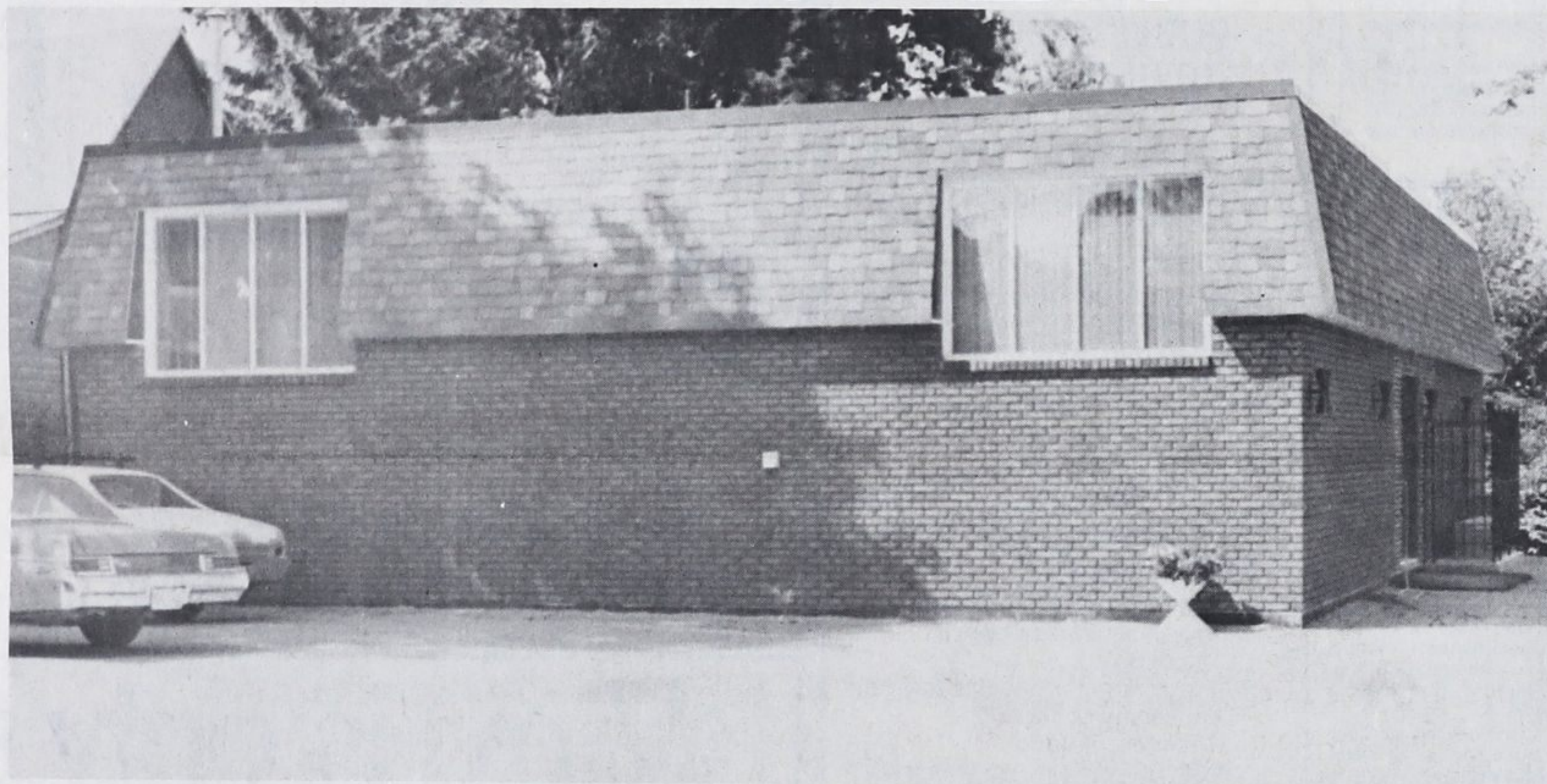

Because most of these programs are recreation programs, the community at large will be the major beneficiary from these federally funded summer employment projects.
