

Perkinsfield, Lafontaine schools to be repaired

Renovations to cost Catholic school board \$100,000

A number of major and minor renovations to schools under the Simcoe County Roman Catholic Separate School Board will cost the board just under \$100,000 this year.

According to a report released at the board's July 20 meeting, the board will

spend \$44,100 on major projects including asphalt, roofing and carpeting in its county schools.

Midland's Sacred Heart School will get new carpeting in two of its classrooms, nine rotted windows at Victoria Harbour's St. Mary's School will be replaced

with aluminum and St. John's in Waubushene will get an asphalted 40 x 60 area basketball court.

Sacred Heart School

will also have the lower portion of its walls sporting a fresh coat of paint before the year is out, repairs will be made

to the exterior and interior of the school and the play area will be levelled with fill. Similar minor repairs will be carried out at Monsignor Castex and St. Theresa's in Midland.

In Lafontaine, Ste Croix School will have four of its classrooms in the east section painted, stair

treads, exit doors on the old building will be replaced and basement windows repaired.

Martyrs Canadiens' leaky roof will be repaired under the Separate School Board's renovations program, hall floor tiles will be replaced, a hot water tank will be added to the

kitchen and a number of minor repairs undertaken.

St. John's in Waubushene will be sporting a spanking new paint job on its exterior woodwork, and among other improvements will have a new fence between its playground and neighbouring houses.

Victoria Harbour's St. Mary's School will have its washroom walls repaired, a new set of front steps installed and new basketball posts and backboards.

In Elmvalle, Our Lady of Lourdes may have a greener lawn next summer as the board intends to fertilize and re-

seed the new lawn area. The storage shed will be retained and will get a new door and the west entrance double doors will be replaced.

Painting schools throughout the county will cost the Separate School Board approximately \$12,000, minor projects such as

roof repairs, asphalt, recaulking etc will cost another \$28,000, \$8,000 has been allocated for 'unforeseen emergency projects' and another \$7,000 will be spent on building utilities such as boilers, burners, carpentry, plumbing and fire inspections in the board's 26 schools.

and in emergency situations in the community.

The course runs for two semesters of 16 weeks each.

The Pharmacy Assistant program, also a two semester program, is designed to enable the student to acquire the knowledge, skills and competency to assist professional pharmacists in the delivery of quality health care in both hospital and community pharmacy environments. In addition, the student is exposed to courses in communications and business-oriented subjects to enhance career opportunities.
