

New disaster cast introduced in 'Airport '77' at Pen

Fasten your seat belts, moviegoers! The latest of the "Airport" movies begins tomorrow at the Pen Theatre in Penetang. The original "Airport", made in 1970, was an adaptation of a best-selling novel by Arthur Hailey. It's all-star cast included Burt Lancaster,

Dean Martin, George Kennedy, Helen Hayes and Van Heflin, among others. It was one of the biggest hits of that year. The next movie was called "Airport '75", although it was released in the fall of 1974. It starred Charlton Heston, Karen Black, Gloria Swanson and, again,

George Kennedy. The result was another solid box-office hit. The newest airline disaster opus coming to the Pen is called "Airport '77". Like its predecessors it has a big cast. George Kennedy is back again, but many members of the cast are new to the disaster movie cycle.

They include Jack Christopher Lee, best known for the role of pilot; Lemmon, of course, Dracula and most often

is mostly noted for his typecast in horror comedy roles. movies, has a change of

pace in "Airport '77" as a famous oceanographer. Also along for the ride on the doomed plane are Lee Grant in the role of the oceanographer's shrewish wife, Darren McGavin as a jet designer, Brenda Vaccaro as a stewardess and veteran film stars Olivia deHavilland and Joseph

Cotten. Also in the cast, but not on the plane, is another famous oldtimer, James Stewart. He plays a small but important role as a millionaire, who is jetting his friends and art treasures from Washington to Florida for a museum opening. Not too much of the plot

in this type of movie should be given away. It is sufficient to note that the story is about a Boeing 747 which has a collision with an oil derrick and crashes in the Bermuda triangle. On the same program with Airport '77 is another exciting actioner, a war picture called Midway.

Midway is a well-made large-budget recreation of the Battle of Midway, an important naval battle in the Pacific between America and Japan during World War Two. The story is told from both sides. The solid cast of name stars includes Charlton Heston, Henry Fonda, Glenn Ford,

Robert Mitchum, Robert Wagner and Hal Holbrook. The Car starts this evening at the Odeon Theatre in Midland. The Car is an offbeat movie which is a combination of supernatural thriller and car-chase action. The Car is about a small-town desert community which is terrorized by a mysterious driverless car which appears out of nowhere and runs down pedestrians. James Brolin stars as the deputy sheriff who frantically attempts to stop the deadly car's reign of terror.

The Midland Drive-In begins a double bill tonight of Adios Amigo! and Grand Theft Auto, starring and directed by Happy Days' Ron Howard. This Sunday evening a double feature begins of Ode To Billy Joe and The Song Remains The Same.

Funeral services were held at St. Ann's in Penetanguishene and interment followed there.

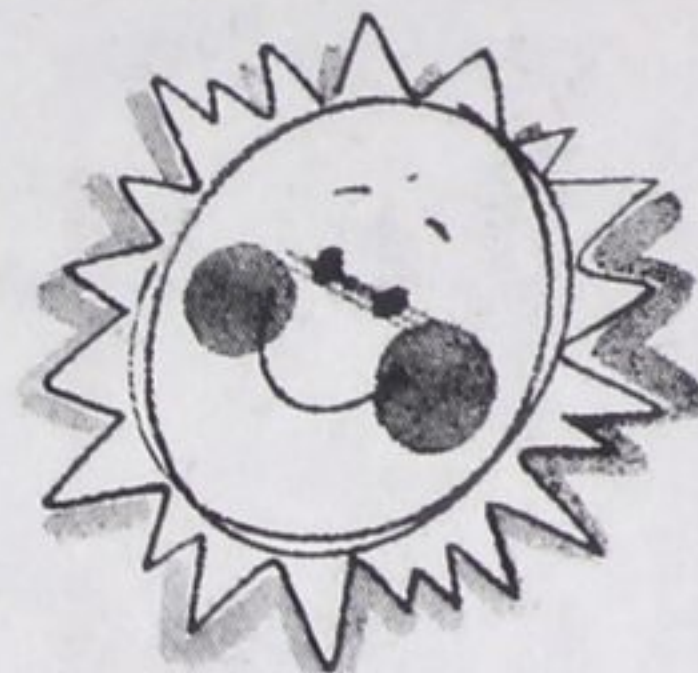
A Therrien
