Wedding Anniversary of Mr. and Mrs. E. Asselin of Midland, and formerly of this village. Congratulations.

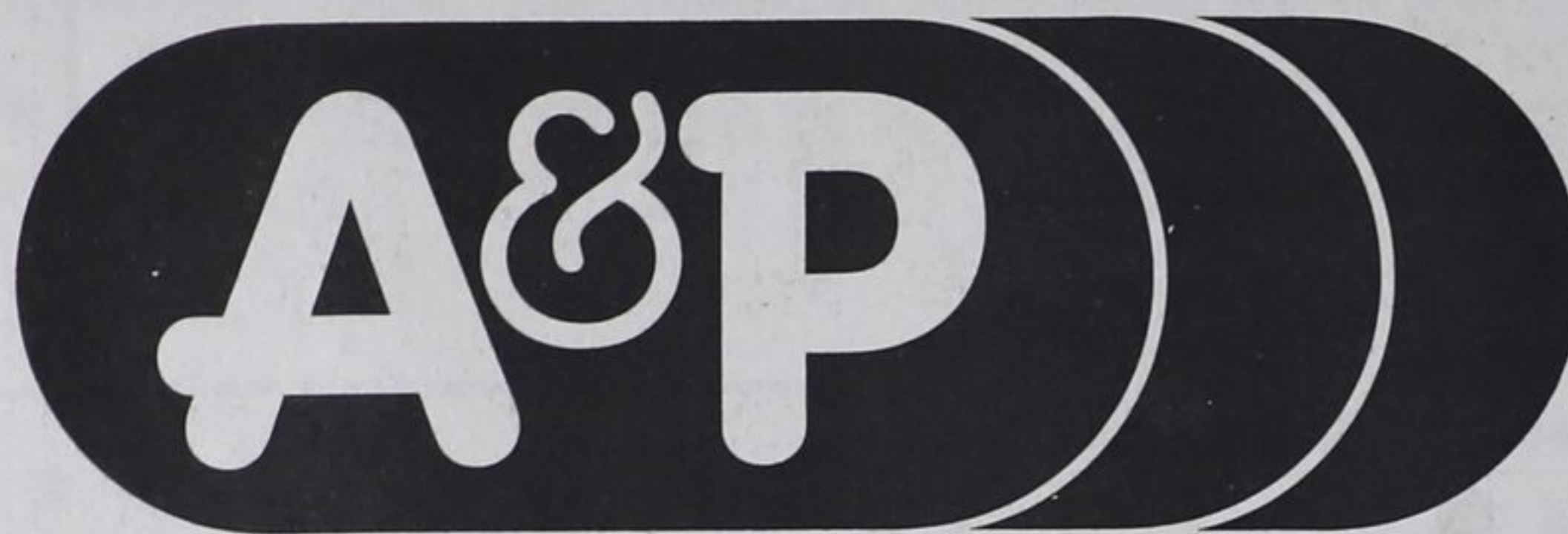
Mr. and Mrs. B. Smitten are pleased to announce the safe arrival of their new daughter Andrea Lynn, who
