The 4-H Queen's Guineas Steer Competition for the 1977 Royal Winter Fair has attracted 435 nominations this year, only six head short of the record set last year. There are six classes: Aberdeen Angus, Herefords, Shorthorns, Charolais Cross, Simmental Cross and Crossbreds and Other Breeds. Twenty-eight counties across Ontario have registered entries and three of these entries are from the Coldwater area.

Coldwater News

Coldwater will be entering "Starsky" a white-faced Hereford. Ann Mason's Black Angus "Big Mac" has qualified, as well as her sister Shirley's Hereford, "Henrie". The Mason farm is located in Medonte.

To be eligible to compete in the "Guineas" an exhibitor must be a qualified member of an Ontario 4-H calf club in 1977; have participated in a local Achievement Day; have completed all phases of the 4-H project to the satisfaction of the club leader and Extension Branch personnel; and be at least 14-years of age on January 1, 1977.

The steers, to be eligible must have made an average daily gain of at least 2.1 lbs. during the five month period, May 15 to October 15, 1977; weigh at least 850 lbs. on October 15, 1977 and be cared for and housed on

and trained to stand for showing. It is fed a balanced diet and a record must be kept of the type of food and the cost, as well as the monthly weight gain.

A final culling will be done the evening of Thursday November 17 by a special committee at the Royal. Show day is November 18 and the judge is Andy Brown, Lethbridge, Alberta.

A Champion and Reserve Champion will be selected in each class, followed by the selection of Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Queen's Guineas Steers.

A public auction of all Queen's Guineas steers is held the same afternoon at the Royal, commencing at 2:00 p.m. Last year's 1180 lb. Grand Champion Aberdeen Angus steer, owned by 16-year-old Robert Hasson of Guelph, sold to Dominion Stores for \$5900.00.

Trailer regulations distress Waubaushene resident

Mr. Frost's complaint against the township's mobile home bylaws stems out of a dilemma he is facing personally.

Seven-day notice
For financial reasons the transaction never materialized.

Last week, Frost was given notice by the township that he must vacate the property within seven days. He approached Tay officials and received an extension of 15 days on the original notice, during which time he must find a location for his trailer. He also noted that the property's owner, who also owns the building in which the

Frost's restaurant is housed, has been applying pressure on the family to remove the trailer from the premises.

The problem, says Frost, is that local trailer parks, for various reasons, are unsuitable for his requirements. He said Smith's Trailer Camp in Midland told him that prospective tenants buy their trailers from Smith's itself before locating in the camp. Frost inquired at the Bramhill Trailer Park and was told that a capital outlay of \$1350.00 is required before a

trailer can be situated on the property. Frost says he can't afford the cost. Edward's Trailer Park, also in Tay, is a strictly adult facility, explained Frost, unsuitable for his family of five.

Frost says that he will approach Tay Council with a petition asking it to rescind or change the zoning regulations of its mobile home bylaw. He also said he is prepared, if Council is agreeable, to relocate his mobile home on a property he owns once the school year is over.

Y plans sale, Nov. 26

During the sale people looking for good used skates or ski equipment are invited to make a purchase from the wide selection of articles on display.

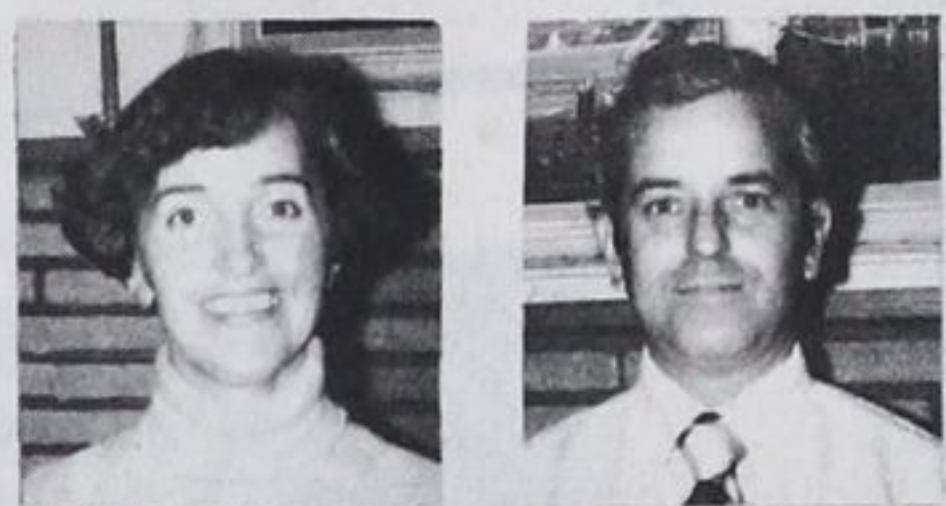
It is stressed that articles to be sold must be brought to the Y.M.C.A. before November 26.

Tay bylaws stipulate that any mobile home brought into the township must be located in a serviced mobile home park, unless the owners have procured an approved building permit. Tay clerk Walter Lumsden noted that these bylaws are the result of an order by the Ontario Government placing strict zoning regulations on the location of mobile homes.

In March of this year his Waubaushene house was levelled by fire. After insurance claims were settled, he purchased a mobile home, and located it on a vacant property next to his store. At the time Tay Township agreed to let Mr. Frost locate his trailer on the property, as he had indicated that he would be purchasing the property and renovating a house
