

Mr. Lennox said that the Commodore "will buckle down on the door" to enforce any new legal drinking age.

Although in favour of the proposed legislation, Mr. Lennox said that "he wouldn't mind even if they raised it to 20"

He also expressed some concern as to the effects of a raised drinking age. "They've gotten used to drinking, and I'm afraid they'll get into trouble out on the streets now that they can't get into bars. We need youth centers, or chaperoned youth dances for kids to go to", he remarked.

Midland Police Chief Ernie Bates said that he "doesn't think" raising the drinking age to 19 years is sufficient-it should be raised to 20".

He explained that since the drinking age was lowered in 1975, he suspects that alcohol related incidents in Midland have been on the

"I've got to say that we've probably had more incidents of wilful damage to public and private property. Although I don't have any facts or figures, I suspect that this increase is related to the lower drinking age", he speculated.
