CARE brings aid to India

CARE has authorized an increase to \$165,000 worth of initial aid and almost three million pounds of food in response to additional information from CARE officials in India on the destruction and loss of life caused by the two cyclones that recently struck Tamil Nadu and Andhra Pradesh, leaving at least 10,000 dead and hundreds of thousands homeless.

"Many times that amount is needed to help feed, clothe and shelter the stricken survivors as well as begin reconstruction". Thomas Kines, CARE Canada National Director, said. Besides the distribution of food made available from the supplies for regular CARE child feeding programs, the relief agency has purchased water purifier powder and thousands of blankets, clothing and tarpaulins for the victims.

In another cable, CARE's field representative described flash floods which destroyed 46 villages. He said plans already are being implemented for construction of an initial group of 40 low-cost houses for the homeless in the hard-hit village of Vallipatti, the first of which is expected to be completed within a week. Vallipatti is located below a mile-wide dam which was partially destroyed. Contributions may be sent to CARE India Cyclone Fund, 1312 Bank St., Ottawa K1S 5H7.
