

## Ogilvie irked by 'money'

At a meeting of Midland Town Council on Monday night, Deputy Reeve Bill Ogilvie once again objected to council calling 1978 Midland's centennial and he called the centennial coins a 'funny money' operation.

The Reeve was commenting on the Mayor's proclamation which names the centennial coin the centennial dollar and says that the centennial committee agrees to redeem the coins at the face value of a dollar on or before December 31,

Ogilvie said, "the town into shouldn't get guaranteeing the redemption of this coin.' He told council to seriously look into the legalities of the coins and what the Criminal Code of Canada has to say in regards to printing them up. He said, "I don't want to see us end up with an indictable offence."

He asked if the coin was a publicity stunt in election year and said if it was, the Mayor should consider putting his picture on it.

Before anyone could answer, Ogilvie once again began to complain about the town naming 1978 as Centennial year. He pointed out that the first council did not sit until January 1, 1979 and therefore centennial year should be 1979.

Mayor Lynn told Ogilvie that the question of centennial year was like a marriage. He asked, was it legal when the ceremony takes place or when it was consummated?
