Midland Police News

Toronto man charged by Midland police in auto case

A Toronto man has been charged by Midland Police with possession of stolen goods over a value of \$200.

Charged is John Francis Wilcox of Toronto.

Wilcox was charged at 4:40 p.m. on Friday, December 9 with possessing an auto which was reported stolen in Toronto at 9 a.m. the previous day.

Wilcox is presently awaiting trial.

Failing to signal charge
 A two car crash which occurred on Dominion Avenue at 12:40 p.m. on Saturday, December 10 resulted in \$500 damage to one of the vehicles involved, and a charge of failing to signal while decreasing speed being laid against a Penetanguishene man.

Police say that cars driven by Todd Lewis of Penetanguishene and Wilfred Pilon of Midland were both travelling eastbound on Dominion

Avenue when the Lewis car suddenly stopped without signalling, causing the Pilon vehicle to smash into its rear.

Lewis' car received no damage in the mishap, while the Pilon auto sustained \$500 damage. There were no injuries.

Colborne street man charged

Midland Police have charged a Colborne Street man with failing to yield from a private entrance following a mishap which occurred December 10, at 3:00 p.m.

Police say that William Stevens was pulling out of a driveway on Bay Street when a car driven by Douglas Stewart of Victoria Harbour passed by, and unable to stop soon enough apparently crashed into his auto.

Stevens, besides being charged, had his car damaged to the tune of \$500, while the Stewart car received \$600 damage.

No driver's license
 Midland Police investigated a single car accident which occurred at the intersection of Johnson and Ellen Streets Saturday evening.

According to police, Ross James Hackney of Midland was travelling northbound on Johnson Street towards Ellen Street, when on approaching a stop sign at the intersection, applied his brakes and skidded on the icy road surface. He went through the stop sign, coming to rest against a fence.

The accident resulted in \$200 damage to Hackney's car and \$150 total damage to the fence and the sign.

Hackney has been charged with driving without a license.

Icy driveway mishap
 Cars driven by Fred Hehl of Penetanguishene and Marilyn Minifie of Midland came into collision on Eighth Street,

December 11 at 1:30 p.m.

Police say that Hehl was backing from steep icy driveway when his car slid into the Minifie vehicle.

Hehl's car was damaged \$500, and Minifie's vehicle received \$100 damage.

No charges were laid.

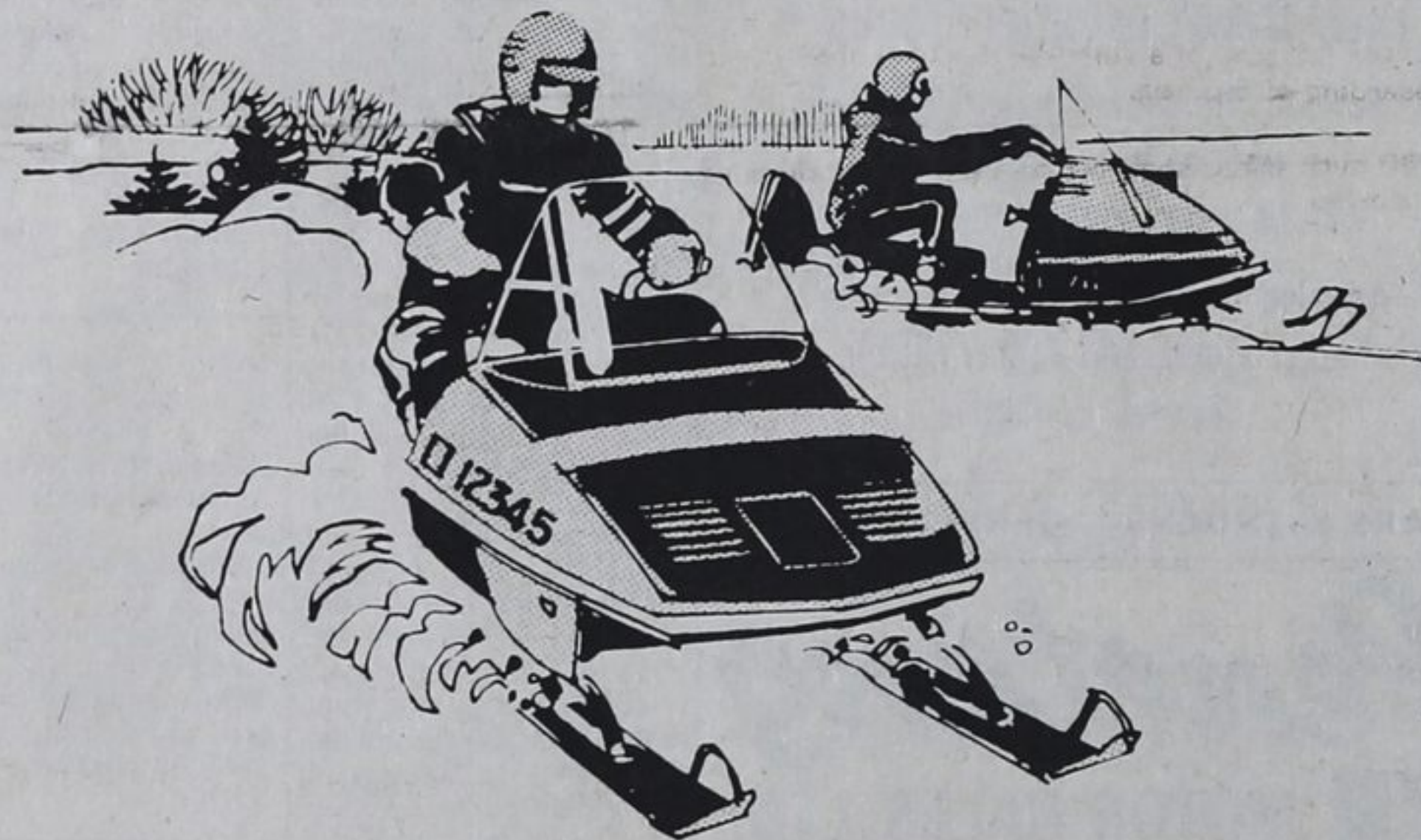
Parked car mishap
 At noon on December 11 a car driven by Heather Brunelle of Bayview Drive in Midland crashed into a parked car belonging to Lloyd R. Scott of Birchwood Drive.

Police say the accident occurred when the Brunelle auto attempted to stop at the intersection of Bayview and Birchwood Drive, skidded, and smashed Scott's car, which was parked on Birchwood Drive.

Icy road conditions were blamed for the accident, which resulted in the Brunelle car receiving \$500 in damage, and the Scott car, \$50.

youngsters aged 12 to 15 and persons 16 and over who don't have an Ontario Motor Vehicle Driver's License. Graduates receive a proficiency certificate that must be validated as a snowmobile operator's license at any MTC driver examination centre for a \$2.00 fee.
