EXPLANATORY NOTE TO BY-LAW NO. . 7.8-8.

The following is an explanatory note to By-law No. .78-8. which amends By-law No. 74-14, as amended (the Comprehensive Zoning By-law for the Village of Elmvale):

The Village of Elmvale has received an application requesting that the lands in part of Lot 6. Concession IX be zoned to permit the development of a senior citizens' apartment by the Ontario Housing Corporation.

This By-law creates a Special Residential Type 3 Zone for the subject lands. Schedule "A" to this By-law changes the zone symbol on the said lands from R1 to R3-2.

This By-law becomes effective when passed by Council subject to its approval by the Ontario Municipal Board.

A BY-LAH TO AMEND ZONING BY-LAW NO. 74-14

BY-LAW NO. .78-8.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Elmvale deems it advisable to amend By-law No. 74-14, as amended;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Elmvale ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 9 of By-law No. 74-14 is hereby amended by the addition of the following at the end thereof:

SPECIAL RESIDENTIAL TYPE 3 ZONE (R3-2)

Hotvithstanding any provisions of Section 9(1) hereof to the contrary, on any lands designated R3-2 on Schedule "A" hereto. no person shall use any land or erect, alter or use any building or structure for any purpose except one or more of the following special uses, namely:

(a) RESIDENTIAL USES:

a senior citizens' apartment.

(b) NON-RESIDENTIAL USES:

a public use.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS FOR R3-2 ZONES Notwithstanding any provisions of Section 9(2) hereof to the contrary, no person shall, on any lands designated R3-2 on Schedule "A" hereto, use any land or erect, alter or use any building or structure except in accordance with the following

special provisions: (a) LOT AREA (minimum): - 23,000 square feet LOT FRONTAGE (minimum): - 105 feet FRONT YARD DEPTH (minimum): - 11 feet

(d) INTERIOR SIDE YARD WIDTH (minimum): - 25 feet

REAR YARD DEPTH (minimum): - 10 feet LANDSCAPED OPEN SPACE (minimum): - 35% LOT COVERAGE (maximum):

DWELLING HOUSES PER LOT (maximum): - 1 only

(1) ACCESSORY USES, PARKING, ETC: In accordance with the provisions of Section 5 hereof."

2. Schedule "A" attached to and forming part of By-law No. 74-14 is hereby amended by changing to R3-2 the zone symbol of the lands designated "ZONE CHANGE TO R3-2" on the attached Schedule "A" hereto. 3. This By-law shall become effective on the date hereof, subject to

receiving the approval of the Ontario Municipal Board.
