Consider garden size

GUELPH - When choosing vegetables to grow, consideration must be given to the size of garden, family preference and the area where it is located. With good planning, the yield of the average family garden can be doubled. cultivation.

When selecting a place for the garden, use the area with the most sunlight, good drainage and good soil If the garden is small, soil conditions can be improved by adding topsoil, peat, manure or some other additives.

Higher yields are obtained from crops grown in small areas with better environmental conditions. even though some of them may be artificial, than larger shaded and poorly drained areas. A daily minimum of six hours of sunlight are necessary. If the only sunny areas are patios or open driveways. plants can be grown in boxes of 12 to 18 inches of topsoil.

In a small garden, one or two vegetables such as tomatoes, peppers and radishes are all that should be grown. Spaceconsuming crops such

as squash, melon, cucumbers and potatoes should be avoided. In other words, concentrate on crops which respond to intensive

asparagus, rhubarb and chives in the perennial flower borders. Through proper
