By base regulations, the only personnel allowed to hunt or fish on DND land at CFB Borden are members of the Base Borden Rod and Gun Club. This privilege is naturally subject to training requirements which take priority.

Fishing on Base

In the interest of safety for personnel who wished to use the training areas, policy was introduced prior to the 1977 fall hunting season which required all members to obtain a range pass from the range control office, building 0-102, room 126. This procedure was determined to be necessary to safeguard both hunters and individuals training in the area. The same hazards

do not exist for fishing. Effective 05 May 78 members of the Rod and Gun Club may fish in the training area south of the Lisle Road without securing a pass. They must still check the range safety map located at the club house prior to proceeding to the area and must carry the normal club identification. In addition they must have the club sticker on their POMV. When troops are booked into specific areas then these areas are out of bounds for fishing or movement.

Those members who wish to fish north of the Lisle Road must obtain a range pass because of the inherent dangers of the live firing areas. Passes are available at IBase Range Control Office, Room 126, Building 0-102 (Base Headquarters) during normal working hours.
