Midget age players are being called to tryout Sunday, at 2 p.m. at the main diamond.

At a meeting of the MMBA Wednesday, Wencker said all-star coaches met to discuss the five teams entered in the YSBA this year and he said chances are good that both teams would be filled.

"We decided to go with a bantam B team (as well as the A team) because of the number of players we had out last year. Most of them happened to be of an age where they would be returning this year and we had a number of peewees who turn out, there should be enough to have a B team."
