Students hire students

General Business students at Georgian College in Barrie recently "hired a number of students in the graduating class of the Early Childhood Education (ECE) program.

It was part of a unique co-operative interview experience for the ECE students arranged by business instructor Harold Stiver at the request of Gary Woodill, a member of the ECE teaching staff.

Although most young people acquire academic or technical competency in the classroom, studies have shown that many lack the skills required to identify their own

potentials and relate them to existing job opportunities.

The exercise helped the ECE students develop confidence and overcome nervousness during the interview, and to assess their own abilities and present them to a potential employer.

Each student applicant was required to face a battery of questions from a three-person employer panel during the 30-

minute interviews.

General Business students participate in interview sessions as part of the regular training and to provide them with sufficient background to

conduct relevant interviews with ECE students, they toured the Raggedy Ann Day Care Centre on Campus and observed the children at play.
