 1/2 cup water
 1 tbs. salt
 1 tsp. allspice
 1 tsp. ground cloves
 1 tsp. cinnamon
 1/4 tsp. cayenne pepper.
 Boil until thick. A double batch makes about 8 pints. Good Luck!


